## **NOTICE OF VIOLATION**

*Of the Soil Erosion and Sediment Control Ordinance  
(Chapter 248 of the Cecil County Code)*

You are hereby notified that the above site is in violation of Chapter 248 of the Cecil County Code (Soil Erosion and Sediment Control Ordinance) and Chapter 251 of the Cecil County Code (Stormwater Management Ordinance). Any violation of Chapter 248 or 251 shall be deemed a misdemeanor, and the person, partnership or corporation who is found guilty of such violation shall be subject to a fine not exceeding five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00), or one (1) year of imprisonment for each and every violation.

Failure to comply with this notice shall be deemed justification for suspension or cancellation of the permit. The corrective action(s) noted below must be initiated within three (3) business days and completed within five (5) business days of the date of this notification. If the corrective action(s) noted below are not completed within five business days of this notification a **stop work order** (suspension of permit) will be placed on the site or the permit may be canceled.

NOTE THAT A **STOP WORK ORDER** WAS POSTED AT THE SITE ON JUNE 13, 2008.

**Nature of Violation(s):**

Chapter 248-

- 3A – Failure to obtain a grading permit prior to the disturbance of more than 5,000 square feet of earth.
- 7A – You may not clear or grade land without first obtaining an erosion and sediment control plan from the Cecil Soil Conservation District.

Chapter 251-

- 4A – Failure to obtain a stormwater management plan.

**Corrective Action(s) Required:**

- You must contact the Cecil Soil Conservation District at 410-398-4411, x-3 to determine the requirements to obtain an erosion and sediment control plan for the site.
- You must apply for a grading permit with the Permits & Inspections Department.
- You must contact the Department of Public Works at 410-996-5265 to determine the requirements to obtain stormwater management approval for the site and the work proposed.

Upon correction of the violation(s) above, it is the responsibility of the permit applicant to contact the Sediment & Stormwater Branch inspector at 410-996-5267 for a reinspection of the site and to request a release of the stop work order (suspension of permit). A reinspection fee of \$50.00 will be assessed for each inspection conducted to determine if violations have been satisfactorily addressed and a fee of \$125.00 will be required to release the stop work order. Payment of the reinspection and reinstatement fees will be required prior to issuance of the Certificate of Use and/or Occupancy.
