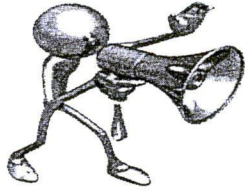

IMPORTANT INFORMATION AND POLICIES OF CECIL TRAVELERS

SERVICE: Trip services are arranged by volunteer services of Arlene Zappo and Linda Cox. Trips are offered to all Cecil County seniors (55 and older). Contract payments to coach and tour companies are from travelers only. Tours are not subsidized by any other funding. Volunteer arrangers are responsible for all payments. We try to offer the best tour at the lowest cost possible. In order to do so, we must enforce the payment and cancellation policy.

RESERVATIONS:

- To reserve a seat, call Arlene or Linda between the hours of 9:00am and 8:00 pm. Caller's name will be placed on interested list.
- A deposit or full payment should be received within seven business days to guarantee reservations.
- NOTICE: Sorry, time **DOES NOT** permit payment reminder calls. After the seven business day period, if payment has not been received, the reservation will be available to other clients.
- Regretfully, if **FINAL** payment isn't received by "final payment date," your deposit will be returned.

ALL SEATING is assigned in advance, according to passenger's final payment date. Our coach seats will be labeled with names of passengers.

You may pay in full as soon as you would like – no need to wait for our Social.

CANCELLATION POLICY: After contracts are signed with the tour companies [final payment date], REFUNDS are NOT available. Each passenger is responsible for his/her seat. Passengers who are unable to make a trip are responsible for finding their own replacement. Arlene and Linda will assist only if there is a waiting list

BOARDING THE COACH:* Boarding is at "CECIL COLLEGE (formerly Cecil Community College), ONE SEAHAWK DRIVE, NORTH EAST, MD., ROUTE 272/NORTH EAST ROAD. Boarding begins 15 minutes prior to departure time.

Overnight travel seating is assigned in advanced according to final payment date. We DO NOT participate in rotation of seats

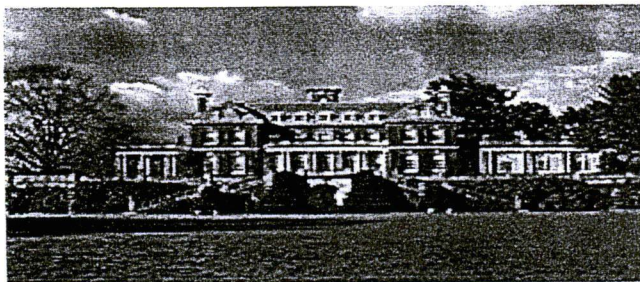

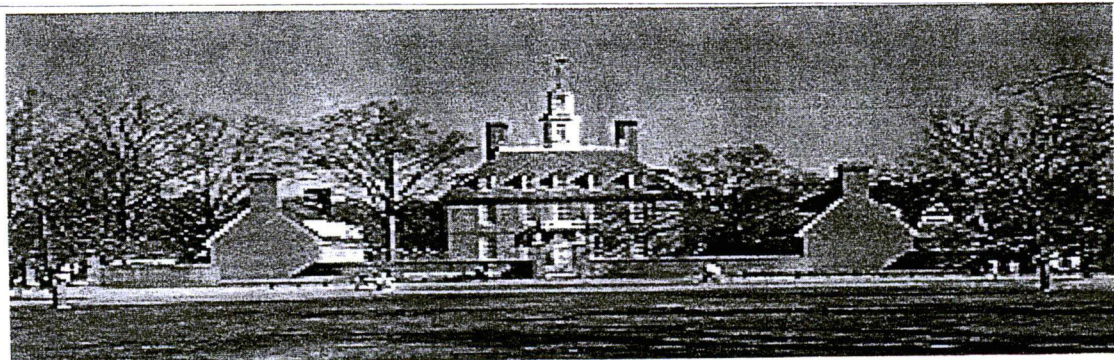

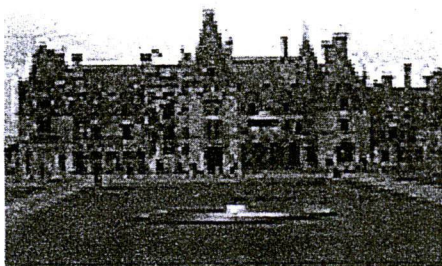
Christmastime at the Biltmore House & Smoky Mountains

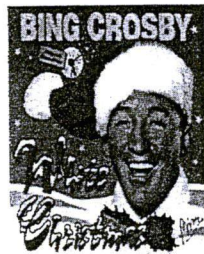

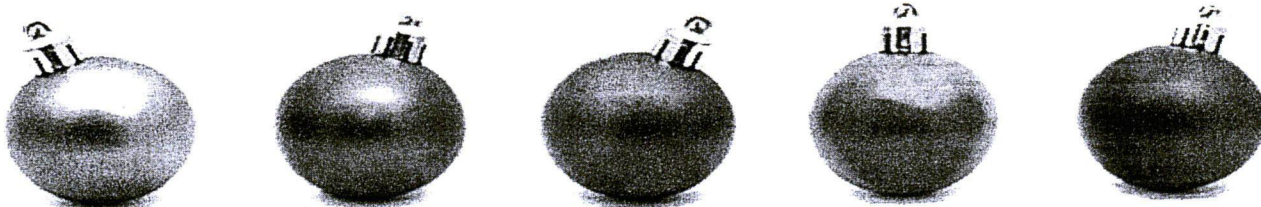
Dutch Apple presents "White Christmas"
