

# Frequently Asked Questions



## **I'm not a senior; can I ride your buses?**

Yes, anyone can ride our transit vehicles. We work on a first come, first serve basis. However, in some rural areas of the county, service is limited.

## **Do you come to my house and pick me up?**

Yes, we have demand response buses that go to the curb of your residence. Our buses must be able to turn around in your driveway as we do not stop on the road or back in or out of driveways.

## **Is there a cost for riding the buses?**

Yes and the cost will vary according to your location, age and ability. We take only exact change. Refer to the links, for our rates, on the home page.

## **I'm in a wheelchair, do you provide escorts?**

We provide curb to curb service only. You must provide your own Personal Care Attendant (escort) if you need help getting from your home to the bus and from the bus to your destination. All of our buses have wheelchair lifts and are accommodated to transport a standard 30"X48" wheelchair.



## **Do you just go to medical appointments?**

Medical appointments are our priority, but you can use our services to get to other destinations as well.

## **Can I catch your bus at a bus stop?**

We have 2 fixed route buses that travel the Route 40 corridor. You can catch our fixed route service "The Bus" at bus stops in Elkton, Glasgow, North East & Perryville. Refer to the links on the home page for our times and locations.
