

## SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING

All Cecil County Solid Waste Facilities

Single Stream Recycling allows recyclables, including paper and cardboard, to be mixed together in one container. **This type of recycling does not separate the recyclables from the trash.** Single stream sorts the recyclables themselves. **Residents must continue to separate their recyclables from their refuse.** Recycling is not mandatory in Cecil County, but incentives exist for those who recycle.

### What can be mixed together for recycling?

- Aluminum, Tin, & Steel Cans
- Glass Bottles
- Narrow Neck Plastic Bottles
  - ⇒ Codes #1,2,3,4,5,6,&7
  - ⇒ Soda Bottles
  - ⇒ Detergent Bottles
  - ⇒ Fabric Softener Bottles
- Newspaper
- Cardboard
- Shredded Paper (bagged)
- Mixed Paper
  - ⇒ Magazines
  - ⇒ Catalogs
  - ⇒ Cereal & Soda boxes
  - ⇒ Printer & Copier Paper
  - ⇒ Mail
  - ⇒ Telephone Books
  - ⇒ Frozen Food Boxes

# Cecil County Solid Waste Guidelines & Fee Schedule

## Scrap Metal

Scrap metal and Freon units can be brought to the Cecil County Central Landfill FREE OF CHARGE. However, the following restrictions apply:

- PROPANE CONTAINERS ARE NOT ACCEPTED IF VALVE IS NOT REMOVED
- BARRELS OF ANY KIND ARE NOT ACCEPTED UNLESS EMPTY & CUT IN HALF
- FUEL TANKS MUST BE EMPTY AND CUT IN HALF

## Free for Recycling

  - ⇒ KEROSENE
- **BATTERIES**
  - ⇒ LEAD-ACID
  - ⇒ HOUSEHOLD
  - ⇒ RECHARGEABLE
- **FLUORESCENT LAMPS/ TUBES**
- **TEXTILES/ CLOTHING**

## Single Stream Recycling

Cecil County gives an incentive to residents that recycle their weekly household refuse.

**IF ALL HOUSEHOLD REFUSE IS SEPARATED FOR RECYCLING, WITH ALL RECYCLABLES REMOVED, AND PRESENT ON THE LOAD, THERE IS NO FEE.**

All recyclables and refuse must be placed in clear trash bags to qualify. Containers of recyclables must be easily inspected. Household refuse is defined as items that are used or consumed on a daily or weekly basis that can be put into trash bags or cans. Household trash does not include cleanout items, or bulky items such as furniture, or construction debris.

The recycling codes 1, 2, 3,4, 5, 6, & 7 for plastics can usually be found on the bottom of the container. Only plastic containers with openings more narrow than the body of the container can be accepted for recycling. Glass bottles and jars can be clear, brown, green, or blue.

Cans, glass, plastics, newspaper, cardboard, and mixed paper can be mixed or commingled together for recycling through Single Stream Recycling.

The following are not recyclable at the Cecil County Landfill, at this time.

## Proof of Residency

All users of the County's Solid Waste Facilities shall provide proof of residency in the form of a Maryland Drivers license with a valid Cecil County address on it, work order, or DPW issued permit to the Solid Waste Facility Representative.

## Fees

If landfill scales are in service, solid waste will be accepted and charged at a rate of \$52.00 per ton, except as follows:

<i>(in clear trash bags with all recyclables removed &amp; recyclables on board)</i>	
<b>UNDER 200 LBS. OF WASTE</b>	<b>\$5.00</b>

**THE 200 POUND LIMIT IS AT THE DISCRETION OF THE WEIGHMASTER ON DUTY**

**NO LIQUID OR HAZARDOUS WASTE SHALL BE ACCEPTED AT ANY OF THE SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL FACILITIES.**

## Mulch

The Cecil County Central Landfill offers MULCH to residents. The mulch must be loaded by the resident and paid for prior to loading.

## Tires

Residents may bring up to 4 tires per day for disposal at the following fees:

### **LIGHT TRUCK/ CAR TIRES**

<b>ON RIM</b>	<b>\$4.00/EA.</b>

### **LARGE TRUCK TIRE (Up to R24)**

<b>OFF RIM ONLY</b>	<b>\$5.00/EA.</b>
