

Citizen Scrap Tire Drop-Off Day

On Saturday, September 15, 2007 Cecil County DPW, Solid Waste Management Division held Cecil County Citizen Scrap Tire Drop-off Day at the Central Landfill from 7:30 am to 3:30 pm. Eighty-nine residents participated in the event and recycled 356 tires.

The next Citizen Scrap Tire Drop-Off Day will be sponsored by the Maryland Environmental Service and the Maryland Department of the Environment. It will take place on Saturday, May 17, 2008 from 7:30 am to 2:30 pm at the Cecil County Central Landfill. This event will be open to Cecil County Residents Only. Residents must show their drivers licenses with their valid Cecil county address on it. Only one vehicle per residence may dispose of up to ten small passenger car & light pickup tires. Addresses will be tracked. The tires must be under 18", but can be on or off the rim. No heavy truck tires, tractor tires, equipment, or agricultural tires will be accepted. No commercial tires or vehicles will be allowed. Tire acceptance or denial is at the discretion of the facility. Transfer Stations are not participating in this event.
