

## **HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE DAYS WITH MEDICATIONS ACCEPTANCE - NEXT EVENT: SUNDAY, 10/4/09**

The Cecil County Landfill, Woodlawn, and Stemmers Run Transfer Station accept oil, antifreeze, fluorescent lamps, and lead acid batteries Monday through Saturday during regular operating hours.

The Cecil County Landfill also holds Household Hazardous Waste Day two times a year. One Saturday each spring and fall, Cecil County residents can bring in their household hazardous waste to the landfill free of charge.

The following materials are accepted on Household Hazardous Waste Days:

- Household Chemicals
- Stains & Thinners
- Latex & Oil Paint
- Gasoline, brake & Transmission Fluids
- Insecticides & Weed killers
- Adhesives & Glues
- Swimming Pool Chemicals
- **Medications**
