You are hereby notified that the above site is in violation of Chapter 248 of the Cecil County Code (Soil Erosion and Sediment Control Ordinance) and Chapter 251 of the Cecil County Code (Stormwater Management Ordinance). Any violation of Chapter 248 or 251 shall be deemed a misdemeanor, and the person, partnership or corporation who is found guilty of such violation by a court of competent jurisdiction shall be subject to a fine not exceeding five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00), or one (1) year of imprisonment for each and every violation.

Failure to comply with this notice shall be deemed justification for suspension or cancellation of the permit. The corrective action(s) noted below must be initiated within three (3) business days and completed within five (5) business days of the date of inspection. If the corrective action(s) noted below are not completed within five business days of the date of inspection a **stop work order** (suspension of permit) will be placed on the site or the permit may be canceled.


Sediment must be removed /cleaned from sidewalk and roadway

Sediment controls must be maintained and in good condition this includes stabilized Construction entrance.

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Upon correction of the violation(s) above, it is the responsibility of the permit applicant to contact the Sediment & Stormwater Branch inspector at 410-996-5267 for a re-inspection of the site to determine if all necessary corrective actions have occurred. The Department of Public Works shall also inspect the site as deemed necessary after issuance of a Notice of Violation until all corrective actions have been satisfactorily completed. A re-inspection fee of \$50.00 will be assessed for each and every inspection conducted to determine if violations have been satisfactorily addressed. Payment of the re-inspection fee(s) for a Notice of Violation will be required prior to issuance of the Certificate of Use and/or Occupancy.

If a stop work order is issued, it is the responsibility of the permit applicant to contact the Sediment & Stormwater Branch inspector for a re-inspection of the site to request a release of the stop work order. The Department of Public Works shall also inspect the site as deemed necessary after issuance of a stop work order until the stop work order is released. A re-instatement fee of \$125.00 will be required to release a stop work order. In addition to the re-instatement fee, a re-inspection fee of \$50.00 will be assessed for each and every inspection conducted during the stop work period to determine if violations have been satisfactorily addressed. Payment of re-instatement and re-inspection fee(s) related to the issuance of a stop work order will be required prior to the release of the stop work order.
