2 Examiners shall review applications and recommend to the County approved electrical inspection
3 agencies; and

4 **WHEREAS**, Pursuant to Section 191-18 of the Code of Cecil County, the County shall appoint such
5 inspectors and license such inspection agencies as defined in the Code as the County so desires to protect
6 the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Cecil County; and

7 **WHEREAS**, Pursuant to Section 191-18 (A), one or more nongovernmental organizations may be
8 designated from time to time as an approved inspection agency or agencies; and

9 **WHEREAS**, Bay Area Inspection Agency and American Inspection Agency currently conduct the
10 electrical inspections in Cecil County; and

11 **WHEREAS**, the Board of Electrical Examiners has reviewed the qualifications of First State
12 Inspection Agency for consideration of First State Inspection Agency’s appointment as an electrical
13 inspection agency; and

14 **WHEREAS**, the Board of Electrical Examiners recommends that First State Inspection Agency be
15 considered for appointment as an electrical inspection agency for Cecil County.
