Title of Bill: Budget Ordinance FY2014 - Appropriations - General Fund - Grant Revenue

**Synopsis:** An Act to amend the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for Cecil County, Maryland for FY2014 in order to provide \$160,795.31 in additions to the General Fund Grants Budget, to provide \$8,700.00 in additions to the Solid Waste Enterprise Fund, and to provide additional appropriation authority for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014.

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 505 of the Cecil County Charter, on March 1, 2013, the County Executive submitted a proposed budget to the County Council for Fiscal Year 2014; and,

- WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 506 of the Cecil County Charter, the County Council held public hearings on the proposed budget submitted by the County Executive for Fiscal Year 2014; and,
- WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 507(b) of the Cecil County Charter, on May 21, 2013, the County Council adopted the budget for Fiscal Year 2014; and,
- WHEREAS, the County Executive is revising the Fiscal Year 2014 Grant Budget revenue estimate for Cecil County to establish the following amounts within the General Fund and the Solid Waste Enterprise Fund pursuant to an award notification; and are as follows:
- a) The addition of \$1,100 grant revenue and expense to the Department of Human Resources budget for Risk Management Training awarded by the Local Government Insurance Trust.
  - b) The addition of \$8,700 grant revenue and expense to the Solid Waste Enterprise Fund budget for Scrap Tire Recycling Day awarded by the Maryland Environmental Service.
  - c) The addition of \$23,418 grant revenue and expense to the Department of Emergency Services budget for the Flood Warning/Emergency Notification System Expansion awarded by the Maryland Emergency Management Agency.
  - d) The addition of \$11,856.22 grant revenue and expense to the Department of Emergency Services budget for the Phone System Call/Position Status Board project awarded by the Emergency Number Systems Board.
  - e) The addition of \$9,962.40 grant revenue and expense to the Department of Emergency Services budget for the Protocol Upgrade Network Connectivity awarded by the Emergency Number Systems Board.
  - f) The addition of \$11,856.25 grant revenue and expense to the Department of Emergency Services budget for the Protocol Licensing and Software awarded by the Emergency Number Systems Board.
  - g) The addition of \$23,625 grant revenue and expense to the Circuit Court budget for 40 hours of basic mediation training for the ADR (Alternative Dispute Resolution) Program awarded by the Maryland Mediation and Conflict Resolution Office (MACRO).
  - h) The addition of \$38,040 grant revenue and expense to the Development Services budget for engineered designs of several bio-retention cells at three County schools (North East Elementary,

- North East Middle, Bay View Elementary ) awarded by the Maryland Department of Natural Resources.
  - i) The addition of \$6,910.25 grant revenue and expense to the Department of Emergency Services budget for Remote Power Monitoring awarded by the Emergency Number Systems Board.
  - j) The addition of \$23,115.54 grant revenue and expense to the Department of Emergency Services budget for the Aurora 2.0 MIS Software Update awarded by the Emergency Number Systems Board.
  - k) The addition of \$6,200 grant revenue and expense to the Department of Emergency Services budget for Air Conditioning the back-up PSAP (Public Safety Answering Point) awarded by the Emergency Number Systems Board.
  - The addition of \$4,711.65 grant revenue and expense to the Department of Emergency Services budget for headsets for PSAP's 9-1-1 positions awarded by the Emergency Number Systems Board. and,

WHEREAS, such appropriation is necessary to provide \$160,795.31 grant funding for the General Fund and \$8,700 for the Solid Waste Enterprise Fund Grant Program expenditures; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 506 of the Charter of Cecil County requires that no final budget action may be taken by the County Council until after public hearing or hearings have been held in open public session: and,

WHEREAS, County Council has caused notice of a public budget hearing on the recommended appropriation to be published in a newspaper of general circulation in Cecil County; and,

**WHEREAS**, on September 3, 2013, the County Council held a public budget hearing on the recommended appropriation and can now, therefore, take action thereon.

### NOW THEREFORE,

Section 1. Be It Hereby Enacted by the County Council of Cecil County, Maryland that the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for Cecil County, Maryland for Fiscal Year 2014 is hereby amended for the supplemental appropriation and by amending the Current Expense Budget to appropriate additional expenditures in the General Fund to (a) increase the General Fund by the amount of \$160,795.31 and, (b) increase the Solid Waste Enterprise Fund in the amount of \$8,700.

# FISCAL NOTE SUBMITTED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE ON BEHALF OF THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE

#### **SUBJECT:**

Bill No. 2013-08 – Budget Ordinance FY2014 – Appropriations – General Fund – Grant Revenue

**<u>FISCAL IMPACT</u>**: The approval of this resolution will not have any net fiscal impact on the Cecil County Government.

## **Further Detail:**

This bill proposes an amendment to allocate a series of grants that affect the General Fund and the Solid Waste Enterprise Fund. According to Article 5 Section 511 of the Cecil County Charter, "On the recommendation of the Executive, the Council may make supplemental appropriations from any contingency appropriations in the budget; from revenues received from anticipated sources but in excess of budget estimates; or from revenues received from sources not anticipated in the budget."
