Strike through indicates language stricken out of a Bill by amendment WHEREAS, Pursuant to Section 9-234(a) of the Environment Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland, the Maryland Department of the Environment receives applications for a sludge permit application; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Section 9-234(a) of the Environment Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland, the Maryland Department of the Environment is required to mail a copy of the permit applications immediately to the legislative body and elected executive of any county within 1 mile of the sewage sludge utilization site; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Section 9-234(a) of the Environment Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland, the Maryland Department of the Environment is required to publish only one notice of the application for one week only in a local newspaper having a substantial circulation in the county where the sewage sludge is to be applied or the facility is to be constructed; and

WHEREAS, there have been instances in Cecil County where adjoining property owners to the proposed sludge site have been unaware or uninformed about the proposed application; and

WHEREAS, notices from the Maryland Department of the Environment to the Cecil County Council and County Executive may not indicate the actual street location of the proposed sludge site; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Planning and Zoning of Cecil County has responsibilities to oversee the planning of physical development and growth of the county and maintains records for land use, boundaries and property maps; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Section 317 of the Cecil County Zoning Ordinance, the Department of Planning and Zoning of Cecil County is responsible to give notice of hearings on zoning changes, applications for variances and special exceptions.

- Section 1. Be It Hereby Enacted by the County Council of Cecil County, Maryland that a new section of the Code of Cecil County to be titled Chapter 310, State Sludge Permit Applications is hereby enacted to read as follows:
- 27 301 STATE SLUDGE PERMIT APPLICATIONS
- 28 A. UPON RECEIPT OF THE NOTICE FROM THE MARYLAND STATE DEPARTMENT OF THE 29 ENVIRONMENT OF A PROPOSED SLUDGE PERMIT APPLICATION, THE DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING AND

- 30 ZONING OF CECIL COUNTY SHALL IDENTITY THE GEOGRAPHIC LOCATION OF THE PROPOSED SLUDGE
- 31 SITE AND THE ADJOINING PROPERTY PARCELS AND PROPERTY OWNERS.
- 32 B. WITHIN FIFTEEN (15) DAYS AFTER THE RECEIPT OF THE NOTICE OF A SLUDGE PERMIT
- 33 APPLICATION, THE DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING AND ZONING SHALL SEND NOTICES TO ALL PROPERTY
- 34 OWNERS IMMEDIATELY CONTIGUOUS TO THE APPLICATION, TO THE EXTENT POSSIBLE BASED ON BEST
- 35 AVAILABLE INFORMATION.
- 36 C. THE NOTICE REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION SHALL IDENTIFY THE SITE THAT IS SUBJECT TO THE
- 37 APPLICATION AND ITS GEOGRAPHICAL AREA AND EXPLAIN THAT ANY PROPERTY OWNER CAN CONTACT
- 38 THE CECIL COUNTY COUNCIL OR COUNTY EXECUTIVE TO REQUEST A PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING OR
- 39 HEARING.
- 40 D. WHEN THE DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING AND ZONING RECEIVES NOTICE FROM THE MARYLAND
- 41 DEPARTMENT OF THE ENVIRONMENT THAT A PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING OR HEARING HAS BEEN
- 42 SCHEDULED, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL SEND NOTICES WITHIN FIFTEEN (15) DAYS TO ALL PROPERTY
- 43 OWNERS IMMEDIATELY CONTIGUOUS TO THE APPLICATION, TO THE EXTENT POSSIBLE BASED ON BEST
- 44 AVAILABLE INFORMATION.
- 45 E. THE NOTICE REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION SHALL IDENTIFY THE SITE THAT IS SUBJECT TO THE
- 46 APPLICATION, ITS GEOGRAPHICAL LOCATION AND SHALL STATE THE DATE, TIME AND LOCATION OF THE
- 47 PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING OR HEARING.
- 48 Section 2. And Be It Further Enacted that this Act shall take effect sixty (60) days following its
- 49 enactment.
