Title of Bill: Supplemental Appropriation - Board of Education Capital Projects - BTOP

Synopsis: A bill to amend the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for Cecil County, Maryland for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016 in order to provide an additional \$580,000 of bond revenue and expenditure authority within the Board of Education Capital Projects fund to allow for the final phase of funding of the Broadband Technology Opportunities Program (BTOP) project.

Supplemental Appropriation – Board of Education Capital Projects - BTOP

1 **WHEREAS**, in accordance with Section 505 of the Cecil County Charter, on April 1, 2015, the County
2 Executive submitted a proposed budget to the County Council for Fiscal Year 2016; and

3 **WHEREAS**, in accordance with Section 506 of the Cecil County Charter, the County Council held
4 public hearings on the proposed budget submitted by the County Executive for Fiscal Year 2016; and

5 **WHEREAS**, in accordance with Section 507(b) of the Cecil County Charter, on June 2, 2015, the
6 County Council adopted the budget for Fiscal Year 2016; and

7 **WHEREAS**, the County Executive is revising the Fiscal Year 2016 Board of Education Capital Projects
8 Budget to establish bond revenue and expenditure authority for the Board of Education in the amount of
9 \$580,000 to complete the BTOP project; and

10 **WHEREAS**, the final phase of the BTOP project includes additional hardware and equipment to be
11 installed at the remaining Board of Education sites to connect all buildings owned by the Board of
12 Education and that such items outlined by the BTOP project are eligible to be included in the FY2016 CIP
13 Budget.

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CECIL COUNTY, MARYLAND**, in
15 legislative session that the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for Cecil County, Maryland for
16 Fiscal Year 2016 is hereby amended to add \$580,000 in bond budget authority within the Board of
17 Education Capital Projects fund to allow for completion of the BTOP project; and

18 **AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this Act shall take effect 60 calendar days from the date that it
19 becomes law.
