21		(b)	PERSO	NS WHO POSSESS A VALID MARYLAND WEAR AND CARRY PERMIT; OR,
22		(c)	PERSO	NS WHO HAVE BEEN ISSUED A VALID STATE OF MARYLAND HUNTING LICENSE,
23			WHO	MAY LAWFULLY POSSESS A HUNTING FIREARM ON PARK PROPERTY:
24			(i)	FOR THE PURPOSE OF TRANSPORT OF A BOAT;
