2	Zoning Ordinance, Zoning Maps, and Subdivision regulations; and

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14	Home Occupations. A business conducted [entirely within an enclosed dwelling unit] by the resident,		
15	which is incidental and secondary to residential occupancy and does not change the residential character of		
16	the [dwelling] PROPERTY.

19	amendment to the Zoning Ordinance, Article V, Part III, § 79, Home Occupations (3.05.000) is hereby		
20	adopted as follows:

22	Home occupations may be permitted in the RMU zone and permitted as a Special Exception in the NAR,		
23	SAR, RR, LDR, ST, VR, UR, MH, RM and MEA zones provided that:		
24	1. Home occupations are [in the same building as the residence] CONDUCTED ON THE SAME		
25	PROPERTY AS THE RESIDENCE and do not change the residential character [and appearance] of the		
26	[dwelling] PROPERTY.		
27	6. No equipment or process shall be used which creates noise, vibration, glare, fumes, odors, or electrical		
28	interference detectable [outside of the dwelling] FROM ADJOINING PROPERTIES.
