WHEREAS, the County Executive has recommended that Cecil County, Maryland, a body corporate
and politic of the State of Maryland (the "County"), endorse the Maryland Stadium Authority's (the "MSA")
application to the Department of Business and Economic Development of the State of Maryland (the
"DBED") for a grant (the "Grant") from the Maryland Economic Development Assistance Authority and
Fund (the "MEDAFF") in the amount of Forty Nine Thousand Dollars (\$49,000.00) (the "Grant"); and
WHEREAS, the Grant is to be used to assist with the costs of a study to determine the feasibility of a
Horse Park in Maryland (the "Study"); and
WHEREAS, the Grant will be used in accordance with Maryland law relating to MEDAAF, namely,
Sections 5-301 through 5-349 of the Economic Development Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland,
inclusive, for the purposes set forth in the application described above; and
WHEREAS, the MSA will provide matching funds for the Study; and
WHEREAS, the MSA will contract for all services associated with the Study; and
WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 5-322 (a) (6) of the Economic Development Article of the
Annotated Code of Maryland, the governing body of the jurisdiction in which the Project is located shall
evidence its approval by formal resolution; and
WHEREAS, the County has determined that it is in the best interests of the citizens of Cecil County
that the Study be carried out as above described.
NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Cecil County Council does hereby fully endorse the
Study and the MSA's acceptance of the Grant;
AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that This Resolution shall be effective upon its adoption in
accordance with applicable law.
