## **PUBLIC HEARING**

Notice of time, place of public hearing and title of this Resolution having been posted on <u>April 8, 2015</u> at the County Administration Building, 200 Chesapeake Blvd., Elkton, Maryland and having been published on <u>April 8, 2015</u> and April 15, 2015. A public hearing was held on <u>April 21, 2015</u> and concluded on <u>April 21, 2015</u>.

1	WHEREAS, Maryland's Enterprise Zone Tax Credit Program is a joint effort between the
2	State and local governments to provide tax incentives to businesses and property-owners located
3	in economically distressed communities;
4	WHEREAS, the Cecil County Enterprise Zone was approved by the State of Maryland on June 15,
5	2013, thus providing an important economic development tool for the County and the towns of Perryville,
6	North East and Elkton;
7	WHEREAS, the Cecil County Office of Economic Development desires to have the current Zone
8	expanded to allow existing businesses in Cecil County and prospective new businesses to utilize these
9	incentives;
10	WHEREAS, the application will include the town of Port Deposit, including 1,248 acres of Bainbridge,
11	and 3.498 acres of Tome's Marina;
12	WHEREAS, the primary benefits to businesses that are located within an Enterprise Zone are
13	eligibility for local property tax credits and State income tax credits;
14	WHEREAS, eligible businesses in an enterprise zone may claim a ten-year credit against local real
15	property taxes on a portion of real property improvements. The credit is 80 percent of the assessment
16	increase during the first five years. The credit then decreases 10 percent annually thereafter to 30 percent
17	in the tenth year;
18	WHEREAS, eligible businesses in an enterprise zone may claim one-year or three-year credits for
19	wages paid to new employees in new positions. The general credit is a one-time \$1,000 credit
20	per new worker. For economically disadvantaged employees, the credit increases to a total of
21	\$6,000 per worker distributed over three years. Businesses claim the enterprise zone income tax
22	credits on the 500CR form when they submit their business or individual income tax returns to
23	the Comptroller.
24	WHEREAS, the Enterprise Zone is an important incentive for the County to access to encourage
25	existing businesses to expand and in attracting new businesses to locate within Cecil County.
26	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the County Council of Cecil County, Maryland is in
27	support of this application to expand the Cecil County Enterprise Zone to include the Town of Port Deposit.
28	AND, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency

measure and necessary for a situation that was unanticipated, urgent, a pressing and compelling need

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- requiring immediate action in order to submit the enterprise application to the Maryland Department of Business and Economic Development,
- AND, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall take effect on the date of its passage by
  the County Council of Cecil County, Maryland.
