WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 402 of the Cecil County Charter (the "Charter"), the County 1 Executive (the "Executive") shall see that the affairs of the executive branch are administered properly 2 and efficiently, and that employees of the executive branch faithfully perform their duties; and, 3 4 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 402 of the Charter, the duties and responsibilities of the Executive 5 include, but are not limited to: (a) Supervising and directing offices, agencies and divisions of the executive branch and ensuring that County employees as well as County boards and commissions 6 faithfully perform their duties; and, (b) preparing and submitting to the Council the annual County 7 8 Budget; and WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 60, Article I, § 60-2 of the Cecil County Code (the "Code"), the 9 10 Sheriff must keep a correct and full statement or schedule of all persons committed to the jail, showing the length of time and the charge upon which they are committed, and the name of the officer , which 11 statement or schedule, together with all books, papers and commitments kept by him pertaining to 12 13 prisoners in the jail, shall at all times be open to inspection by County officials or employees; and 14 WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 60, Article I, § 60-2 of the Code, at the first meeting of the Council in each month, the Sheriff shall make to the Council, under oath, a full and complete report of all persons 15 16 confined in the jail, with a statement of the length of time, the offense for which they are committed and 17 the name of the officer by whom they were committed; and WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 60, Article I, § 60-2 of the Code, the same sums of money 18 hereinbefore authorized to be levied and paid the Sheriff shall be in full of all claims of said Sheriff against 19 Cecil County for his care, labor, responsibility and expense in discharging the duties of his office, including 20 the keeping safely in jail of prisoners committed to his custody, supplying to said prisoners the provisions 21 furnished for them, by the County, properly cooked and served in a proper and sanitary condition as 22 hereinbefore provided, and keeping the jail in a clean and tidy condition; and 23

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 60, Article I, § 60-2 of the Code, the County shall not pay said

Sheriff for any service he may render in the discharge of his official duties any further or other

compensation and shall not be in any way liable for any fees now or which may hereafter be allowed said

Sheriff by law, or for any further compensation than that as above provided; and

WHEREAS, the County provides the Sheriff with an inmate weekend housing (work release) fee in accordance with pursuant to Chapter 60, Article I, § 60-1 of the Code; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 408 of the Charter (Tax Levy and Balanced Budget), after enacting the Annual Budget and Appropriations Ordinance, the Council shall levy the amount of taxes required by the Budget to ensure that the Budget is balanced so that proposed revenues equal proposed expenditures; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive has submitted this resolution to set the inmate weekend housing (work release) fee for the Sheriff in accordance with in accordance with pursuant to Chapter 60, Article I, § 60-1 of the Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ENACTED by the County Council of Cecil County, that in accordance with Chapter 60, Article I, § 60-1 of the Code and Section 408 of the Charter, the inmate weekend housing (work release) fee to be paid to the Sheriff is Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) per inmate, per day.

AND, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall be effective July 1, 2015 and shall continue in effect until changed by the County Council.
