1	WHEREAS, Division I, Title 8, Subtitle 1, §8-104 et seq. of the Land Use Article, Annotated Code of
2	Maryland authorizes the County to establish regulations and procedures to designate a property as a
3	historic district; and
4	WHEREAS, Article XI, Part IV, Historic District of the Cecil County Zoning Ordinance provides the
5	regulations and procedures to preserve historic districts, landmarks, sites, or structures of historical,
6	archeological, or architectural significance, with their appurtenances and environmental settings, for the
7	public welfare of the residents of Cecil County: and
8	WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Cecil County, Maryland, approved the
9	designation of Brickhouse II, located at 2018 Turkey Point Road, North East, MD, District 5, Tax Map 36,
10	Parcel 138 on May 15, 2012; and
11	WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 337-7. Credit granted, under Article III. Historic Property Tax Credit,
12	Chapter 337 Taxation. of the Code of Cecil County, a property tax of up to 10% of the properly documented
13	expenses of a private owner-taxpayer for the restoration and preservation of a structure that Cecil County
14	determines has historical value may be granted against the County property tax imposed; and
15	WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 337-9, a property credit granted in one year under this article shall
16	only be applied against the current year's property tax; and the amount of property tax credit to be granted
17	shall not exceed the amount of property tax payable against said property in the year that the tax credit is
18	granted; and credit; and
19	WHEREAS, Susan Shannon and E. Leon Demond, are the owners of the property at 2018 Turkey
20	Point Road, North East, Maryland, also known as Brickhouse II; and
21	WHEREAS, Section 337-7 provides a property tax credit of up to 10% of the properly documented
22	expense of the owner-taxpayer for the restoration and preservation of the said parcel; and
23	WHEREAS, Susan Shannon has presented properly documented receipts in the amount of
24	\$25,720.35 for restoration and preservation to Brickhouse II, which has been reviewed and recommended
25	by the Historic District Commission; and
26	WHEREAS, the Real Property Tax bill for the property located at 2018 Turkey Point Road, North East,
27	Maryland, is an annual total of \$3,051.68.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the County Council of Cecil County, Maryland, that Susan Shannon, an owner and a taxpayer at 2018 Turkey Point Road, North East, Maryland, are entitled to a tax credit in the amount of \$2,572.04 on the real property tax.

AND, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall take effect on the date of its passage by
the County Council of Cecil County, Maryland.
