1	WHEREAS, Priority Funding Areas are established to direct future development in the State into
2	established communities that are supported by existing or planned public services, pursuant to State
3	Finance and Procurement Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland, Division 1. State Finance, Title 5.
4	State Planning, Subtitle 7B. Section 5-7B-02; and
5	WHEREAS, Section 5-7B-03 provides that the governing body of a county may designate priority
6	funding areas, and that a Priority Funding Area can be designated by the governing body if an existing
7	community receives a public or community sewer system, and
8	WHEREAS, the County Commissioners of Cecil County certified the Priority Funding Area Map in
9	2009; and
10	WHEREAS, the Town of Chesapeake City will be providing a connection for water and sewer to
11	Station 12 and Paramedic Substation 3 of the Chesapeake City Volunteer Fire Company, located at 2859
12	and 2865 Augustine Herman Hwy, Chesapeake City, Maryland; and
13	WHEREAS, the 15.2 acres that are proposed to be designated as Priority Funding Area are adjacen
14	to the existing Priority Funding Area where the Chesapeake City Volunteer Fire Company is located; and
15	WHEREAS, this property was included in Chesapeake City's 2009 Comprehensive Plan and county's
16	2010 comprehensive plan, which qualifies this property for consideration as a Priority Funding Area as an
17	institutional and employment use; and
18	WHEREAS, the Chesapeake City Volunteer Fire Company is requesting their property to be
19	designated as a Priority Funding Area to be available for state funding.
20	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the County Council of Cecil County, Maryland, tha
21	the proposed 15.2 acres, adjacent to the existing Priority Funding Area, located at 2859 and 2865
22	Augustine Herman Hwy, Chesapeake City, Maryland, be designed as a Priority Funding Area; and
23	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the County Council of Cecil County, Maryland, that the Priority
24	Funding Area map be amended to include this 15.2 acre addition to the existing Priority Funding Area.
25	AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this recertification be submitted to the Maryland Department
26	of Planning for their approval.
