6	Commission shall be composed of five members with staggered four year terms;			
7	WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 39.4(C) of the Code of Cecil County, no more than three members			
8	the Commission shall be affiliated with the same political party;			
9	WHEREAS, the Ethics Commission is currently comprised of two members who are affiliated with			
10	the Republican Party, one member who is affiliated with the Democratic party, and one member who is			
11	unaffiliated; and			
12	WHEREAS, the Ethics Commission is currently comprised of two members who are affiliated with			
13	the Republican Party, one member who is affiliated with the Democratic party, and one member who is			
14	unaffiliated;			
15	WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 412(b) of the Charter of Cecil County, the Executive shall appoint all			
16	members of boards and commissions and that such membership shall be subject to confirmation by the			
17	Council;			
18	WHEREAS, the County Executive approves the reappointment of Robert J. Boonstoppel, who is			
19	registered Democrat, for a four year term to expire July 19, 2020.			
20	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED THAT THE COUNTY COUNCIL confirms the			
21	reappointment of Robert J. Boonstoppel to the Cecil County Ethics Commission for a four year term to			
22	expire July 19, 2020.
