1	WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2-501-502 of the Agriculture Article of the Annotated Code of	
2	Maryland, the Maryland Agricultural Land Preservation Foundation (MALPF) was established in the	
3	Department of Agriculture to protect agricultural land and woodland as open-space land; and	
4	WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2-504.1(a), in each county containing productive agricultural land,	
5	the county governing body shall appoint an agricultural preservation board; and	
6	WHEREAS, the county agricultural land preservation board shall advise the county governing	
7	body with respect to the establishment of agricultural districts; and to approve or disapprove an application	
8	for certification; and	
9	WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2-509(b)(1-2) one or more owners of land actively devoted to	
10	agricultural use may file a petition with the county governing body requesting the establishment of an	
11	agricultural district; and shall refer the petition or application to the county agricultural land preservation	
12		
13	WHEREAS, the county agricultural land preservation board shall advise the county governing	
14	body as to whether or not the land in the proposed district or proposed easement meets the qualifications	
15	established by MALPF; and whether or not the board recommends establishment of the district; and	
16	WHEREAS, the county planning and zoning board shall advise the local governing body as to	
17	whether or not establishment of the district is compatible with existing and approved county plans and	
18	overall county policy, and whether or not the planning and zoning body recommends establishment of the	
19	district; and	
20	WHEREAS, if either the county agricultural land preservation board or the planning and zoning	
21	body recommends approval, the county governing body shall hold a public hearing on the petition; and	
22	WHEREAS, the county governing body shall render a decision as to whether or not an agricultural	
23	district shall be established for this petition or application; and	
24	WHEREAS, the Cecil County Department of Planning and Zoning has recommended approval of	
25	the petition of Steven and Lindsay Haines for property located at 838 Nesbitt Road, Colora, MD 21917,	
26	(Tax Map 9, Grid 24, Parcel 131); and	
27	WHEREAS, the Cecil County Agricultural Land Preservation Advisory Board has recommended	
28	approval of the petition of Steven and Lindsay Haines for property located at 838 Nesbitt Road, Colora,	
29	MD 21917, (Tax Map 9, Grid 24, Parcel 131); and

30	WHEREAS, the Cecil County Planning Commission has recommended approval of the petition
31	Steven and Lindsay Haines for property located at 838 Nesbitt Road, Colora, MD 21917, (Tax Map 9, Grid
32	24, Parcel 131); and
33	WHEREAS, pursuant to Section A385-3 Standards, in Chapter A385. Purchase of Development
34	Rights Program and Fund, in the Code of Cecil County, the Cecil County Purchase of Development Rights
35	Program allows a landowner the option of establishing an agricultural preservation district, a minimum of
36	five-year agreement by the landowner not to develop the land and sets standards.
37	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the County Council of Cecil County,
38	Maryland, that the petition of Steven and Lindsay Haines for property located at 838 Nesbitt Road, Colora,
39	MD 21917, (Tax Map 9, Grid 24, Parcel 131) is approved for the establishment of an agricultural
40	preservation district.
41	AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect in 60 calendar days from the
42	date it becomes law.
