

His father served in the Air Force and came home to go back to school and to become a school teacher. Our grandson, Darren Wayne McKinney is a teacher in the Sacremento, California School System. Michael McKinney is in management in the Rosenberg Corporation, computer expert.



The McKinneys, early settlers in Cecil County, settled in Elk Neck about 1712. As the nation grew, they farmed and fished in this developing region.

In Principio Furnace, Joseph McKinney harvested wood in this richly resourced area. As the McKinney family grew in the region, they observed the formation of a new nation.

On one of their many parcels in Elk Neck, the family saved space for a burial ground. About 1811, Rachel A. McKinney (2 months old) died and was buried on the site. We know about 100 family members are buried there.
