I am pleased to inform you that the Board of County Commissioners, at our meeting of Tuesday, 17 September 2002, approved the nomination to designate the McKinney Family Cemetery as a historic site. The approximately 90' by 90' cemetery has historical significance due to the period of use from 1811 to 1911, that the remains of over 100 individuals representing seven generations of the family are buried therein, that the McKinney family has had a presence in Cecil County since 1712 and that Joseph McKinney, the founder of school #3, is buried in the cemetery.

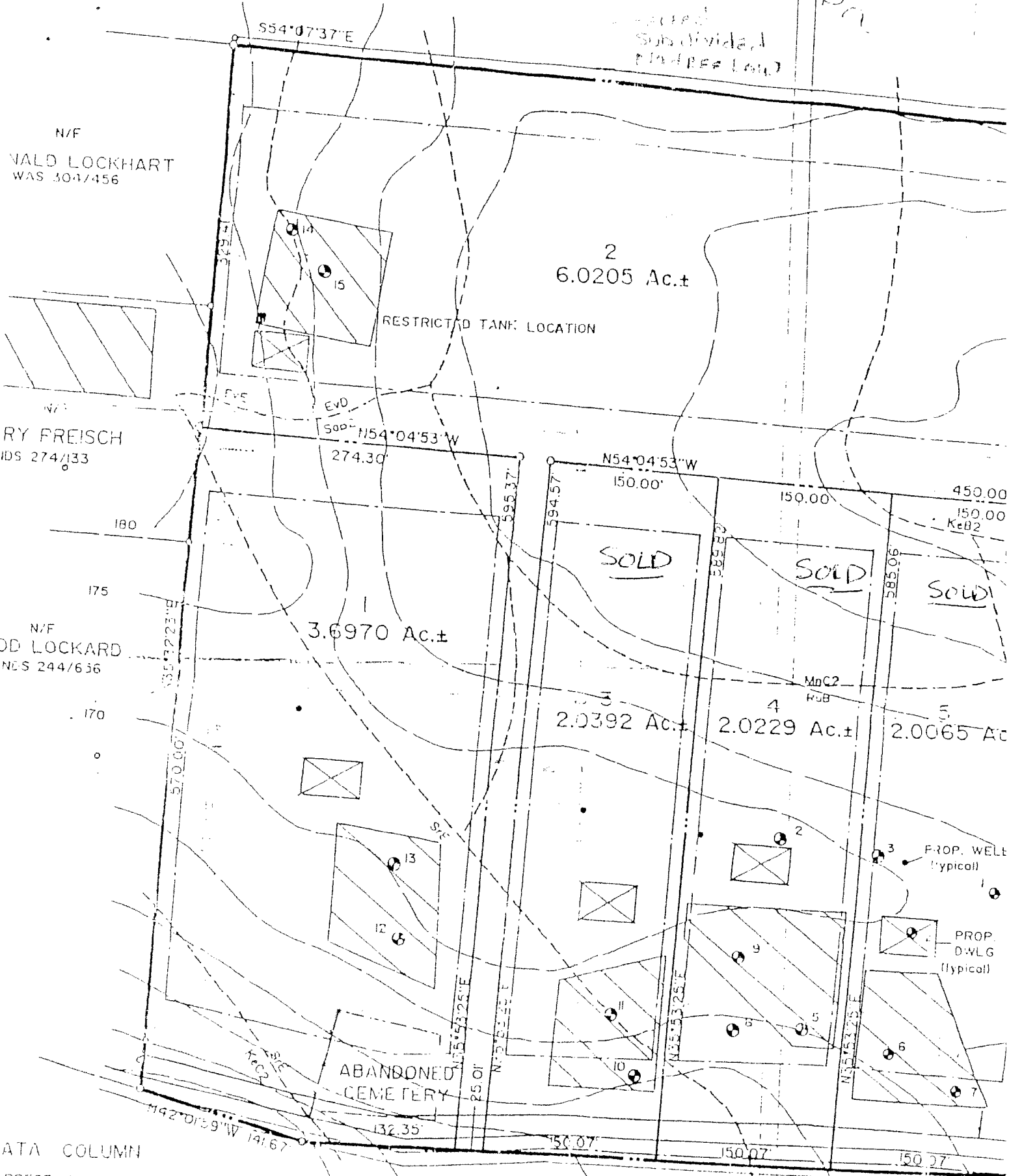

THE DEVELOPMENT PROPOSED

The McKinneys, early settlers in Cecil County, settled in Elk Neck about 1712. As the nation grew, they farmed and fished in this developing region.

In Principio Furnace, Joseph McKinney harvested wood in this richly resourced area. As the McKinney family grew in the region, they observed the formation of a new nation.

On one of their many parcels in Elk Neck, the family saved space for a burial ground. About 1811, Rachel A. McKinney (2 months old) died and was buried on the site. We know about 100 family members are buried there.
