Amendment - Master Water and Sewer Plan - Port Deposit Wastewater Treatment Plant

WHEREAS, the Environment Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland requires the County to have

a Master Water & Sewer Plan and provides for the administration, enforcement, and amendment of Plan;

and

- WHEREAS, an amendment has been proposed to the Master Water & Sewer Plan, Chapter 4, §4.1.7

 Port Deposit, to provide a new wastewater treatment plant with a capacity needed to support the redevelopment of Tome School and Bainbridge sites and replacement of an outdated existing wastewater treatment plant, located in Port Deposit in a 100 year floodplain and to revise Table 13 and Table 7; and WHEREAS, the Department of Planning and Zoning has recommended an amendment to the Master
- WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on these proposed changes before the Planning Commission on
 August 15, 2016; and
- 12 **WHEREAS**, the Planning Commission recommended approval of the proposed amendment.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CECIL COUNTY,
- MARYLAND, that the text amendment to the Master Water & Sewer Plan, Chapter 4., §4.1.7, is hereby

- 16 A. Existing Systems
- 17 Cecil County owns and operates the Port Deposit Wastewater Treatment Plant, two pump stations located in
- the Town of Port Deposit, and the collection system. The current WWTP is a 0.150 mgd packaged activated
- 19 sludge wastewater treatment plant, and the system's two pump stations are packaged "can type" stations.
- 20 Originally constructed in 1971 and currently serving approximately 653 people, the WWTP meets discharge
- 21 permit requirements with annual average flows of 0.06 mgd.

Water & Sewer Plan for Port Deposit Sewerage System; and

- 22 B. Proposed Improvements
- 23 Cecil County Government and the Town of Port Deposit have executed an agreement that contemplates
- 24 potential future decommissioning of the existing plant and construction of a pump station and conveyance
- 25 sewer line to the North East River Advanced Wastewater Treatment Plant. However, this scenario is
- 26 contingent on an adequate funding source being identified and in place by a finite deadline. For the time
- 27 being, the County has decided to replace the existing plant with a new package plant. THE EXISTING PORT
- 28 DEPOSIT WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT (WWTP) IS 40+ YEARS OLD, IS LOCATED ON THE BANKS OF
- 29 THE SUSQUEHANNA RIVER WITHIN THE 100 YEAR FLOODPLAIN, HAS REACHED THE END OF ITS USEFUL
- 30 LIFE, AND NEEDS TO BE REPLACED. THE COUNTY WILL CONSTRUCT AN ENHANCED NUTRIENT REMOVAL

Amendment - Master Water and Sewer Plan - Port Deposit Wastewater Treatment Plant 31 PACKAGED WWTP AT A NEW LOCATION ON THE GROUNDS OF THE FORMER BAINBRIDGE NAVAL 32 TRAINING CENTER. THE WWTP WILL HAVE AN INITIAL CAPACITY OF 250,000 GALLONS PER DAY BUT WILL BE SITED, DESIGNED AND BUILT SUCH THAT IT CAN BE READILY EXPANDED IN STEPS OVER TIME AS 33 NEEDED TO ACCOMMODATE INCREASED FLOWS. THE PROJECT WILL ALSO INCLUDE THE CONSTUCTION 34 OF A SEWER PUMPING STATION AND FORCE MAIN TO CONVEY SEWAGE FROM PORT DEPOSIT UP TO THE 35 SITE OF THE REPLACEMENT WWTP; AND OUTFALL TO CONVEY THE TREATED EFFLUENT FROM THE WWTP 36 TO THE EXISTING OUTFALL WHICH WILL CONTINUE TO BE USED; AND THE DECOMMISSIONING AND 37 DEMOLITION OF THE EXISTING PORT DEPOSIT WWTP ONCE THE REPLACEMENT WWTP IS OPERATIONAL. 38 39 THE PROJECT WILL SERVE EXISTING PORT DEPOSIT RESIDENTS, PROVIDE WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT CAPACITY NEEDED TO SUPPORT THE REDEVELOPMENT OF THE TOME SCHOOL AND BAINBRIDGE 40 SITES, AND OTHER USERS WITHIN ITS SERVICE AREA. 41 REVISED TABLE 13: SUMMARY OF PLANNED SEWERAGE SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS IS SHOWN IN 42 **EXHIBIT B.** 43 REVISED TABLE 7: MUNICIPALLY OWNED COMMUNITY SEWERAGE SYSTEMS IS SHOWN IN EXHIBITS 44 45 A-1, A-2 AND A-3.
