

Previous Inflow & Infiltration ("I&I") studies of the Port Deposit sewer collection system revealed multiple leaks and various other conditions that permit large quantities of storm water and/or groundwater to enter the Port Deposit sewer system. This unwanted water, referred to as I&I, does not need to be treated by a wastewater treatment plant and, in fact, consumes valuable treatment plant capacity and increases operating costs. This project will repair the most pressing leaks in order to minimize the amount of I&I entering the system. Repairs to sewer pipe, manholes and other system components will be made using a variety of techniques including replacing failed sections of pipe, slip lining, and grouting, among others.
