1	WHEREAS, pursuant to section 9-503 of the Environment Article of the Annotated Code of
2	Maryland, each County is required to have a Water and Sewer Plan, and to provide for the administration,
3	enforcement and amendment of the Plan; and
4	WHEREAS, pursuant to section 9-503 of the Environment Article, each county's governing body
5	has the authority to review, revise or amend the Water and Sewer Plan; and
6	WHEREAS, an amendment has been proposed to the Master Water and Sewer Plan, Chapter 1,
7	Section 1.2 Objectives for Water, to add text regarding resource protection and rural conservation
8	districts; and Section 1.3.1.K General Policies Regarding Water Supply and Sanitary Sewerage Systems, to
9	add text regarding sewer service funded by MDE funding; and
10	WHEREAS, the Department of Planning and Zoning has recommended amendments to the Master
11	Water and Sewer Plan; and
12	WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on these proposed amendments before the Planning
13	Commission on Monday October 17, 2016; and
14	WHEREAS, the Planning Commission determined that the text amendments are consistent with
15	the County's Comprehensive Plan; and
16	WHEREAS, before the county governing body adopts any revision or amendment of its county
17	plan, the governing body must conduct a public hearing; and
18	WHEREAS, all requirements of the Environment Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland have
19	been met with regard to the amendment of the Cecil County Master Water and Sewer Plan.
20	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CECIL COUNTY,
21	MARYLAND, that the text amendment to the Master Water and Sewer Plan, Chapter 1, Goals and
22	Objectives, Section 1.2 Objectives for Water and Sewer Facilities and Services for the Land Use Districts, is
23	hereby adopted as follows:
24	Resource Protection and Rural Conservation Districts - Extension of water and sewer systems will not be
25	permitted except in cases of where a threat to public health exists. Private shared facilities may be
26	permitted and can provide an opportunity to preserve large open space areas. THESE AREAS MAY
27	COINCIDE WITH THE MUNICIPAL GREENBELT DESIGNATIONS. ANNEXATION OF THESE AREAS WILL BE

28	SUBJECT TO MAINTAIN THE MINIMUM COUNTY USE STANDARDS ESTABLISHED FOR THESE DISTRICTS
29	AND THE INTENT OF THE MUNICIPAL GREENBELT DESIGNATION.
30	AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CECIL COUNTY, MARYLAND, that
31	the text amendment to the Master Water and Sewer Plan, Chapter 1, Goals and Objectives, Section
32	1.3.1.K General Policies Regarding Water Supply and Sanitary Sewerage Systems, is hereby adopted as
33	follows:
34	Lots shall provide at least the minimum size and area requirements of the zoning district in which they are
35	located and any other applicable local laws, ordinances, and regulations of Cecil County, the Department
36	of Environmental Health or MDE, whichever is more stringent. SEWER SERVICE SHALL NOT BE PROVIDED
37	BY COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL WWTPS THAT RECEIVED MDE FUNDING (EXCEPT FUNDING PROVIDED
38	FROM THE BIOLOGICAL NUTRIENT REMOVAL FUND AND THE BAY RESTORATION FUND) FOR A
39	GROWTH-RELATED PROJECT BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 1998, TO ANY AREA UNTIL IT MEETS STATE
10	PRIORITY FUNDING AREA CRITERIA OR UNTIL IT RECEIVES A PRIORITY FUNDING AREA EXCEPTION,
11	COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL WWTPS IN CECIL COUNTY THAT ARE WITHIN THIS CATEGORY INCLUDE THE
12	CHESAPEAKE CITY WWTP.
13	AND, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CECIL COUNTY, MARYLAND, that
14	this Resolution shall take effect on the date of its passage.
