Synopsis:: A Resolution to amend the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for Cecil County, Maryland, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2017 in order to provide additional appropriation of \$157,000 within the General Fund and \$20,000 of operating revenue and expense appropriation authority within the Information Technology Department for Cecil County's first transition to a new County Executive and County Council under the Charter form of government. It was the determination of the prior County Executive and County Council that transition costs would not be included in the original FY2017 Annual Budget but should instead be determined by the new County Executive and County Council.

	County Executive submitted a proposed budget to the County Council for Fiscal Year 2017; and		
	WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 506 of the Cecil County Charter, the County Council held		
	public hearings on the proposed budget submitted by the County Executive for Fiscal Year 2017; and		
	WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 507(b) of the Cecil County Charter, on June 7, 2016, the		
County Council adopted the budget for Fiscal Year 2017; and			
	WHEREAS, the County Executive is revising the Fiscal Year 2017 revenue estimate for Cecil County		
to increase use of Fund Balance by \$157,000 and to allow the following appropriation within the General			
	Fund:		
	a) The addition of \$45,500 in expenditures to the County Executive's Budget to fund the need		
	for consulting services,		
	b) The addition of \$15,000 in expenditures to the County Council's Budget to fund the need for		
	training, staff, and supplies,		

- c) The addition of \$76,500 in expenditures to the following department budgets for costs related to salary, fringe, and training for changes in Department Heads:
 - Department of Human Resources \$39,000

- Department of Economic Development \$37,500

WHEREAS, the County Executive is revising the Fiscal Year 2017 revenue estimate for Cecil County to increase by \$20,000 the operating revenue and expense appropriation authority within the Information Technology Internal Services Fund (IT Fund) and allow the charges in the General Fund:

- a) The addition of \$20,000 in expenditures in the Information Technology Fund for the costs related to salary, fringe, and training for changes in the Department Head,
- b) The addition of \$20,000 in expenditures for IT-Internal Service Fund Costs to the Department of Administration.

WHEREAS, such appropriation is necessary to provide \$157,000 of fund balance for the General Fund for expenditures within the department's budgets that are affected by the transition to a new County Executive and County Council; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CECIL COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for Cecil County, Maryland for Fiscal Year 2017 is hereby amended for the supplemental appropriation and by amending the Current Budget to appropriate

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\$157,000 of additional expenditures in the Ge	neral Fund and \$20,000 of operating revenue and expense	
appropriation authority within the Information	n Technology Department for Cecil County's first transition	
to a new County Executive and County Council under Charter form of government.
