1 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to the Annotated Code of Maryland, Local Government Article, Section 9-201,
2 the County is authorized to acquire and hold property for a public purpose; and

3 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to the Annotated Code of Maryland, Local Government Article, Section 1-601,
4 the County shall establish, maintain, and conduct a comprehensive program of public recreation and
5 parks for the benefit of the citizens; and

6 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 402 of the Charter of Cecil County, the County Executive shall see
7 that the affairs of the executive branch are administered properly and efficiently; and

8 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 402 of the Charter, the duties and responsibilities of the Executive
9 include, but are not limited to, supervising and directing offices, agencies and divisions of the executive
10 branch; and

11 **WHEREAS**, the County Executive has submitted an amendment set forth herein to the County
12 Council for consideration and approval.

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CECIL COUNTY,**
14 **MARYLAND**, that Subsection 261-5 is hereby amended to add a new subsection 261-5(DD) Tobacco Use,
15 to Chapter 261 Parks and Recreation of the Code of Cecil County, Maryland, as follows:

16 §261-5 Parks rules and regulations

17 **(DD) TOBACCO USE PROHIBITED.**

18 **NO PERSON SHALL AT ANY TIME SELL OR USE TOBACCO PRODUCTS ON OR ABOUT ANY COUNTY PARKS**
19 **AND RECREATION OWNED OR LEASED PROPERTY. TOBACCO PRODUCTS INCLUDE, BUT ARE NOT**
20 **LIMITED TO, CIGARETTES, E-CIGARETTES, VAPORIZERS, PIPES, CIGARS, AND CHEWING TOBACCO.**

21 **AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED** that this Act shall take effect 60 calendar days from the date it
22 becomes law.
