WHAT DOES THE JOB INVOLVE

Correctional Officers maintain order and discipline at the Detention Center 24 hours a day 365 days a year. They ensure the overall security of the inmates and supervise their daily activities. Officers monitor compliance to the established rules and regulations of the facility as well as federal, state, and local laws/ordinances.

QUALIFICATIONS

- High school diploma or GED
- 18 years of age
- Valid driver's license
- Good moral character
- US Citizen/Resident Alien

THE SKILLS NEEDED

Successful Officers possess the following:

- Communication: effectively and concisely relay information verbally as well as in writing
- Judgment and Decision making: quickly assess a situation and determine the appropriate response
- Perception: monitor multiple activities and individuals and predict future behavior
- Understanding: sensitivity to the emotions, conditions and motivations of people of various backgrounds

JOB DUTIES

- Document inmates activities and monitor movement throughout the facility
- Prepare paperwork for booking new inmates and release of existing inmates
- Monitor conformance to facility rules and regulations
- Oversee work assignments of inmates
- Inspect the condition of dormitories and housing units for security and cleanliness
- Search inmates for contraband
- Receive inventory and track
 personal property of all inmates

APPLICATION PROCESS

- Complete application and provide required documents
- Candidates tour the facility
- Background investigation conducted to include interview and fingerprinting
- Second interview conducted with Command Staff
- Selected candidates receive a conditional offer of employment. A polygraph, drug screen, physical and psychological examinations are performed.
- Upon favorable results of required examinations selected candidates are appointed
