1	WHEREAS, pursuant to section 9-503 of the Environment Article of the Annotated Code of
2	Maryland, each County is required to have a Water and Sewer Plan, and to provide for the administration
3	enforcement and amendment of the Plan; and
4	WHEREAS, pursuant to section 9-503 of the Environment Article, each county's governing body
5	has the authority to review, revise or amend the Water and Sewer Plan; and
6	WHEREAS, an amendment has been proposed by Bernard Brown, III, owner of Conowingo Mobile
7	Home Court; to the Master Water and Sewer Plan, Tables 8. Private Community Sewerage Systems; Table
8	9. Single Lot Sewerage Systems; Table 11. Active or Pending NPDES Discharge Permits to separate
9	Conowingo Mobile Home Court and Maybelle Manor Mobile Home Estates sewerage systems; and
10	WHEREAS, the Conowingo Mobile Home Court, without Maybelle Manor Mobile Home Estates,
11	proposes to transition from onsite sewage disposal system to a central wastewater treatment plant, MBR
12	with UV disinfection, with a surface water discharge; and
13	WHEREAS, the Maybelle Manor Mobile Home Estates will continue to utilize their existing septic
14	system without the Conowingo Mobile Home Court; and
15	WHEREAS, this proposal requires the separation of Conowingo Mobile Home Court from Maybelle
16	Manor Mobile Home Estates, which will continue use of its existing septic system; and
17	WHEREAS, the Department of Planning and Zoning has recommended amendments to the Master
18	Water and Sewer Plan; and
19	WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on these proposed amendments before the Planning
20	Commission on Monday, May 15, 2017; and
21	WHEREAS, the Planning Commission determined that the text amendments are consistent with
22	the County's Comprehensive Plan; and
23	WHEREAS, the principal elected official of each municipality in the County has been notified of the
24	plan amendment; and
25	WHEREAS, before the county governing body adopts any revision or amendment of its county
26	plan, the governing body must conduct a public hearing; and
27	WHEREAS, all requirements of the Environment Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland have
28	been met with regard to the amendment of the Cecil County Master Water and Sewer Plan.
