Policies and Procedures for the Cecil County Council - Final Reading of Bills

- WHEREAS, the Charter of Cecil County, Maryland, provides that the County Council of Cecil County, 1 2 Maryland, is the Legislative Branch of government; and WHEREAS, the legislative powers and procedures are outlined in the Charter of Cecil County; and 3
 - WHEREAS, the Charter allows the County Council to adopt additional rules of legislative procedure that may be desirable and not in conflict with this Charter; and
 - WHEREAS, the County Council has determined that additional policies and procedures are necessary to support the legislative process in order to operate in a consistent and efficient manner; and
- WHEREAS, the Policies and Procedures of the Cecil County Council may be amended by the County 8 9 Council according to the legislative procedures in Sections 303-304 of the Charter of Cecil County, Maryland.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CECIL COUNTY, 10 MARYLAND, that the proposed changes to the Policy and Procedures of the Cecil County Council is hereby 11 approved as follows: 12

- Only bills eligible for adoption by the Council under the applicable provisions of law, the 15 16 Charter, ordinance and/or these Policies and Procedures may be scheduled for final 17 reading.
- B) AFTER THE PUBLIC HEARING ON A BILL AND RESOLUTION HAS BEEN CONCLUDED, THE COUNCIL 18 MAY CONSIDER THE LEGISLATION AT THE SAME SESSION UNLESS THE LEGISLATION HAS 19 AMENDMENT OR AMENDMENTS CONSTITUTING A CHANGE OF SUBSTANCE. 20
