WHEREAS, Section 12-405(b)(1) of the Local Government Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland provides that the governing body of Cecil County may sell by public or private sale or lease surplus county real property, and executive and acknowledge any instrument necessary to transfer the property; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 12-405(b)(2) of the Local Government Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland provides that the governing body may contract to transfer an interest in county real property after a public hearing has been held and advertised for two weeks in a newspaper of general circulation in the county prior to the public hearing; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive proposes that Cecil County, Maryland declare Hayes Lane, an unopened "paper" road, abandoned as it runs from Pulaski Highway adjacent to parcels 212, 217, 318, 319, and 671 as more fully set forth on Tax Map 26, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive proposes that Cecil County, Maryland, enter into Agreements of Sale with Eric Polansky and Charmie Polansky, and PLLH, LLC, respectively, for the conveyance of the said Hayes Lane as it runs adjacent to parcels 212, 217, 318, 319, and 671 on as more fully set forth on Tax Map 26, reserving unto the County road widening and utility easements adjoining Pulaski Highway as it runs adjacent to Hayes Lane; and

WHEREAS, the total consideration of purchase for the aforesaid Hayes Lane will be the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00); and

WHEREAS, the County Executive has determined that this property is not needed for government purposes and that the proposed use of Hayes Lane for stormwater management that will serve three (3) adjacent parcels owned by Eric Polansky and Charmie Polansky, serves an important environmental purpose; and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid Hayes Lane is a "paper road" that has not been opened or developed by the County, and dead ends at lands occupied by rail lines of the Philadelphia, Baltimore and Washington Railroad, and so cannot be feasibly utilized as a County throughway.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CECIL COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the County Executive, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute, on behalf of the County, the Agreements of Sale with Eric Polansky and Charmie Polansky, and PLLH, LLC, respectively, for the conveyance of the said Hayes Lane as it runs adjacent to parcels 212, 217,

318, 319, and 671 on as more fully set forth on Tax Map 26, reserving unto the County road

widening and utility easements adjoining Pulaski Highway as it runs adjacent to Hayes Lane in the

amount of \$10,000.00.
