WHEREAS, the governing body of a County has control to open, name, alter, or close roads by
petition, pursuant to Section 12-512(b) of the Local Government Article of the Annotated Code of
Maryland; and
WHEREAS, the State provides that a resident of the county may request, by petition, that the
governing body of a county open, name, alter or close a road; and
WHEREAS, the County Commissioners of Cecil County, Maryland, adopted a policy for the renaming
private maintained roads; and
WHEREAS, the Department of Land Use and Development Services administers this policy by
receiving applications to name a private maintained unnamed road, which must include a petition signed
by a majority of the landowners that have property which accesses on the subject road, and nonrefundable
application fee; and
WHEREAS, requests for road name changes must be introduced for approval before the County
Council of Cecil County at a public hearing; and
WHEREAS, the proposed name of the road shall not be a duplicate of or analogous to a road name
already in use in Cecil County; and
WHEREAS, in the case of private roads, the fee simple owner or owners, if determinable, of the road
shall sign the application for renaming of the road; and
WHEREAS, Margaret Creshkoff has submitted an application to name an unnamed road off of Jacob
Tome Memorial Highway, Port Deposit, Maryland, which includes the current addresses of 2068 Jacob
Tome Memorial Highway, Port Deposit, Maryland 21904; and
WHEREAS, Margaret Creshkoff has submitted a petition to name the private road "Maggies Lane",
signed by Ms. Creshkoff, the sole resident of this road who supports this naming; and
WHEREAS, Margaret Creshkoff is requesting that the County Council waive the requirement of
three principal structures being access from the unnamed private road in order to eliminate confusion and
potential crisis if emergency services cannot locate these residents; and
WHEREAS, the County Council may require the applicant, Margaret Creshkoff to prove the need of
the road naming to apply this waiver; and
WHEREAS, the Department of Emergency Services has indicated no objection to this road name
change.
