Tax Credit - Historic Property - Brick House

WHEREAS, Division I, Title 8, Subtitle 1, §8-104 et seq. of the Land Use Article, Annotated Code of Maryland authorizes the County to establish regulations and procedures to designate a property as a historic district; and

WHEREAS, Article XI, Part IV, Historic District of the Cecil County Zoning Ordinance provides the regulations and procedures to preserve historic districts, landmarks, sites, or structures of historical, archeological, or architectural significance, with their appurtenances and environmental settings, for the public welfare of the residents of Cecil County: and

WHEREAS, the County Council of Cecil County, Maryland, approved the designation of The Brick House, located at 2018 Turkey Point Road, North East, MD, District 5, Tax Map 36, Parcel 138 on May 15, 2012; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 337-7. Credit granted, under Article III. Historic Property Tax Credit, Chapter 337 Taxation of the Code of Cecil County, a property tax of up to 10% of the properly documented expenses of a private owner-taxpayer for the restoration and preservation of a structure that Cecil County determines has historical value may be granted against the County property tax imposed; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 337-9, a property credit granted in one year under this article shall only be applied against the current year's property tax; and the amount of property tax credit to be granted shall not exceed the amount of property tax payable against said property in the year that the tax credit is granted; and

WHEREAS, Susan D. Shannon and E. Leon Demond III, are the owners of the property at 2018 Turkey Point Road, North East, Maryland, also known as The Brick House; and

WHEREAS, Section 337-7 provides a property tax credit of up to 10% of the properly documented expense of the owner-taxpayer for the restoration and preservation of the said parcel; and

WHEREAS, Susan D. Shannon and E. Leon Demond III have presented properly documented receipts in the amount of \$4,609.00 for restoration and preservation to The Brick House, which has been reviewed and recommended by the Historic District Commission, as shown as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, the Real Property Tax bill for the property located at 2018 Turkey Point Road, North East, Maryland, is an annual total of \$3,073.01, as shown in Exhibit B.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CECIL COUNTY,

MARYLAND, that Susan D. Shannon and E. Leon Demond III owners and taxpayers at 2018 Turkey Point

Road, North East, Maryland, are entitled to a tax credit in the amount of \$460.90 on the real property tax.
