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1           **WHEREAS**, pursuant to the Health - General Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland, Title 8  
2 Substance Use Disorders Law, Subtitle 10 Local Drug and Alcohol Abuse Councils, each county shall have a  
3 local drug and alcohol abuse council; and

4           **WHEREAS**, the local drug and alcohol abuse council (the "Council) shall consist of the following  
5 individuals:

- 6 1) The health officer of the local health department or their designee,
- 7 2) The director of the local department of social services or their designee,
- 8 3) The regional director of the department of juvenile services or their designee,
- 9 4) The regional director of the division of parole and probation or their designee,
- 10 5) The State's Attorney for the county or their designee,
- 11 6) The district public defender or their designee,
- 12 7) The county sheriff or their designee,
- 13 8) The president of the local board of education or their designee,
- 14 9) A representative of the county executive,
- 15 10) A representative of the county council,
- 16 11) The county administrative judge of the circuit court or their designee,
- 17 12) The administrative judge of the district court or their designee,
- 18 13) The following individuals appointed by the county executive, as appropriate:
  - 19 i) At least one recipient of addictions treatment services;
  - 20 ii) Two substance abuse providers, at least one of whom has experience with  
21 services to individuals with co-occurring substance abuse and mental health  
22 disorders;
  - 23 iii) At least one substance abuse prevention provider;
  - 24 iv) At least one individual who is knowledgeable and active on substance abuse  
25 issues that affect the county;
  - 26 v) The superintendent, warden, or director of the local corrections facility;
  - 27 vi) At least one other individual who is knowledgeable about treatment of  
28 substance abuse in the county, including members of civic organizations, the  
29 chamber of commerce, health care professional organization or the clergy.

30           **WHEREAS**, the Council shall determine its own governing structure including the appointment of a  
31 chair; and

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32           **WHEREAS**, the Council shall develop and submit a local plan to the Behavior Health Administration  
33 of the Maryland Department of Health and Mental Hygiene; and

34           **WHEREAS**, the local plan shall include the plans, strategies, and priorities of the county for  
35 meeting identified needs of the general public and the criminal justice system for alcohol and drug abuse  
36 evaluation, prevention, and treatment services; and

37           **WHEREAS**, the local plan shall also include a survey of all federal, State, local and private funds  
38 used in the county for alcohol and drug abuse evaluation, prevention and treatment; and

39           **WHEREAS**, the County Executive has appointed Lorri Irrgang to the Cecil County Alcohol and Drug  
40 Abuse Council as an individual who is knowledgeable about treatment of substance abuse in the county;  
41 and

42           **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CECIL COUNTY,**  
43 **MARYLAND** that the appointment of Lorri Irrgang to the Cecil County Drug and Alcohol Abuse Council for  
44 a three-year term is confirmed, term to expire on April 3, 2021.

45           **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CECIL COUNTY, MARYLAND,** that all  
46 provisions of this Resolution shall take effect on the date that the Resolution is approved.
