Master Water and Sewer Plan – Tables - Waste Water Treatment Plants – Elk Neck State Park WHEREAS, the Environment Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland requires the County to have a Master Water & Sewer Plan and provides for the administration, enforcement, and amendment of Plan; and

WHEREAS, an amendment has been proposed to the Master Water & Sewer Plan, to amend Table 10, Inventory of Existing Wastewater Treatment Plants for the Elk Neck State Park indicated as Appendix 1; and

WHEREAS, the Maryland Environmental Service operates the wastewater treatment facility at Elk Neck State Park; and

WHEREAS, the Maryland Environmental Services has requested that Table 10 be amended to reflect their plans to upgrade the wastewater treatment plant at Elk Neck State Park on January 18, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Maryland Department of the Environment is requiring the Maryland Environmental Services to amend the Master Water and Sewer Plan to reflect this upgrade before their proposal can proceed; and

WHEREAS, the existing wastewater treatment plant at Elk Neck State Park is designed for secondary level treatment and is permitted to discharge an average of 60,000 gallons per day; and

WHEREAS, the current flows average 15,000 to 20,000 gallons per day, but weekend and holiday flows can be much higher; and

WHEREAS, the original plant was constructed in the 1970's, and the plant was upgraded with a new flow equalization tank, a new influent pumping station, improvements to the existing treatment equipment, and a new emergency generator in 2006; and

WHEREAS, although the treatment plant produces a secondary level effluent and is in compliance with the current National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit, the Maryland Environmental Services and the State of Maryland propose a higher level of treatment than is required by the permit in order to upgrade the facility to an Enhanced Nutrient Removal (ENR) level of treatment at the same design capacity of 60,000 gallons per day; and

WHEREAS, the architectural engineer will develop and analyze ENR treatment alternatives including membrane bioreactors (MBR) technology, sequencing batch reactors (SBRs) with denitrification filters and multi-staged activated sludge; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission held a public hearing on the proposed changes on
