Great Wolf Lodge – County Personal Property Tax – Tax Credit

WHEREAS, Section 6-302 of the Tax-property Article, Annotated Code of Maryland requires the
governing body of each county to annually set the tax rate for the next taxable year; and
WHEREAS, Section 508 of the Charter of Cecil County requires that County Council shall levy the
amount of taxes required by the Budget; and
WHEREAS, the new "Great Wolf Lodge" (the "Project") seeks to undertake this development
project in the Town of Perryville on 44+/- acres of land along Overlook Parkway adjacent to Hollywood
Casino; and
WHEREAS, the Project is anticipated to create approximately 400 to 600 full and part time jobs,
comprised of any combination of full time and part time jobs by July 1, 2022; and
WHEREAS, total Project costs are estimated to be approximately \$180,000,000 to \$200,000,000;
and
WHEREAS, pursuant to Md. Code Ann., § 9-257, Tax Property Article, the County Council (the
"Council") may, at the request of the County Executive (the "Executive"), grant, by law, a property tax
credit for up to 50% of the County corporation property tax imposed on personal property that is: (1)
not operating property of a railroad or public utility; and (2) owned or leased by a business entity that
has been in operation for no more than 2 years; and
WHEREAS, Md. Code Ann., § 9-257, Tax Property Article further provides that the Council, at the
request of the Executive, may provide, by law, for the amount and duration of the tax credit; and
WHEREAS, the Executive now requests that the Council approve a Fifty Percent (50%) credit, for
a duration of Twenty Five (25) years, not to exceed \$4,500,000, on the County personal property tax for
a new "Great Wolf Lodge" on 44+/- acres of land along Overlook Parkway adjacent to Hollywood Casino
in the Town of Perryville, Cecil County, Maryland.
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CECIL COUNTY, MARYLAND,
that a Fifty Percent (50%) credit, for a duration of Twenty Five (25) years, not to exceed \$4,500,000, on
the County personal property tax for the new Great Wolf Lodge on 44+/- acres of land along Overlook
Parkway adjacent to Hollywood Casino in the Town of Perryville, Cecil County, Maryland, is approved.
AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CECIL COUNTY, MARYLAND, that
the County Executive and Director of Finance will cause the property tax to be collected in the manner
provided by law.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CECIL COUNTY, MARYLAND, that
