The additional expenditure authority will fund the current year budget shortfall resulting

from the increased number of animals being cared for at the shelter.

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 505 of the Cecil County Charter, on April 1, 2018, the 1 County Executive submitted a proposed budget to the County Council for Fiscal Year 2019; and 2 WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 506 of the Cecil County Charter, the County Council held 3 public hearings on the proposed budget submitted by the County Executive for Fiscal Year 2019; and 4 WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 507(b) of the Cecil County Charter, on June 5, 2018, the 5 Budget for Cecil County was adopted for Fiscal Year 2019; and 6 WHEREAS, the County Executive is revising the Fiscal year 2019 revenue estimate for Cecil 7 County to allocate \$140,000 from the Budget Stabilization Reserve Fund to allow the following 8 appropriation within the General Fund: The addition of \$140,000 in expenditure authority for the 9 Division of Animal Service's operating budget to fund the increased cost of caring for the animals. The 10 budget increase is a direct result of the continued increase in the number of animals being cared for by 11 the shelter; and 12 WHEREAS, such appropriation is necessary to provide \$140,000 of fund balance from the 13 Budget Stabilization Reserve Fund for expenditures. 14 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CECIL COUNTY, 15 MARYLAND, that the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for Cecil County, Maryland for Fiscal 16 Year 2019 is hereby amended; and a supplemental appropriation to the Current Budget in the amount 17 of \$140,000 of additional expenditures in the General Fund to the Division of Animal Service's budget is

SUMMARY OF LEGISLATION

RESOLUTION NO. 31-2019 - Supplemental Appropriation - Fund Balance - Animal Services

SYNOPSIS: A resolution to amend the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for Cecil County, Maryland for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019 in order to provide the Division of Animal Services budget within the General Fund additional expenditure appropriation authority in the amount of \$140,000. The additional expenditure authority will fund the current year budget shortfall resulting from the increased number of animals being cared for at the shelter.

FISCAL IMPACT SUMMARY: Net fiscal impact to the County will be \$140,000 of additional expenditures for Fiscal 2019. The budget stabilization reserve fund will fund the additional animal care costs.

FISCAL ANALYSIS:

This bill intends to amend the budget in order to provide the Division of Animal Services additional budget expenditure authority to continue to operate the County's animal shelter. The County owned facility, now in its third year of operations continues to see an increase in the number of animals served. As the number of animals continues to grow, it becomes difficult to estimate an operating budget that will support a population that continues to exponentially increase.

The requested budget increase will go to the line items that are directly associated with animal care, such as:

Salary & Fringe	70,000.00
Animal Supplies	13,000.00
Food Supplies	9,000.00
Medical Supplies	25,000.00
Professional Services	20,000.00
Gas & Oil	3,000.00
Total	140,000.00
