WHEREAS, the County Executive and the County Council of Cecil County, Maryland, recognize 1 the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within Cecil County; and 2 WHEREAS, the Cecil County Department of Land Use and Development Services, under the 3 direction of the County Executive, has prepared the Cecil County Green Infrastructure Plan (2019) in 4 accordance with the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 40 CFR § 122.47, et seq.; and 5 WHEREAS, the Cecil County Green Infrastructure Plan (2019) identifies implementation 6 strategies to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people and property in Cecil County from the 7 impacts of future hazards and disasters; and 8 WHEREAS, Natural Floodplain Functions Plan ("NFP") credit is provided for adopting plans that 9 protect one or more natural functions within the local jurisdiction's floodplain; and 10 WHEREAS, a "green infrastructure plan" identifies open space corridors or connected networks 11 of wetlands, woodlands, wildlife habitats, wilderness, and other areas that support native species, 12 maintain natural ecological processes, and/or sustain air and water resources; and 13 WHEREAS, the Cecil County Green Infrastructure Plan will be incorporated by reference in 14 future resolutions of the County Council within the following County management plans: (1) 15 Comprehensive Plan; (2) Hazard Mitigation Plan; (3) Land Preservation, Parks, and Recreation Plan; 16 (4) Stormwater Management Plan; and, (5) Strategic Plan; and 17 WHEREAS, adoption by the Cecil County Council demonstrates the Council's commitment to the 18 implementation strategies outlined in the Cecil County Green Infrastructure Plan (2019), as shown in 19 Appendix 1 with additional appendices A through K available on the Cecil County website. 20 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CECIL COUNTY, 21 MARYLAND, that the Cecil County Green Infrastructure Plan (2019) is hereby adopted. 22 AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CECIL COUNTY, MARYLAND, that 23 this Resolution shall take effect on the date of its passage. 24 INTRODUCED: August 6, 2019 ADOPTED: August 20, 2019 ATTEST:

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
