WHEREAS, Maryland's Enterprise Zone Tax Credit Program is a joint effort between the			
State and local governments to provide tax incentives to businesses and property-owners located			
in economically distressed communities; and			
WHEREAS, the Cecil County Enterprise Zone was approved by the State of Maryland on			
June 15, 2013, thus providing an important economic development tool for the County and the towns of			
Perryville, North East and Elkton; and			
WHEREAS, the Cecil County Office of Economic Development desires to have the current Zone			
expanded to allow existing businesses in Cecil County and prospective new businesses to utilize these			
incentives; and			
WHEREAS, the application will include all those twenty (20) properties shown on the attached map			
Exhibit A, and the attached parcel listing, Exhibit B, in all totaling 1.786.76 acres, more or less, of which			
372.23 acres more or less lie within the Town of Elkton; and			
WHEREAS, the primary benefits to businesses that are located within an Enterprise Zone are			
eligibility for local property tax credits and State income tax credits; and			
WHEREAS, eligible businesses in an enterprise zone may claim a ten-year credit against local real			
property taxes on a portion of real property improvements. The credit is 80 percent of the assessment			
increase during the first five years. The credit then decreases 10 percent annually thereafter to 30 percer			
in the tenth year; and			
WHEREAS, eligible businesses in an enterprise zone may claim one-year or three-year credits for			
wages paid to new employees in new positions. The general credit is a one-time \$1,000 credit			
per new worker. For economically disadvantaged employees, the credit increases to a total of			
\$6,000 per worker distributed over three years. Businesses claim the enterprise zone income tax			
credits on the 500CR form when they submit their business or individual income tax returns to			
the Comptroller; and			
WHEREAS, the Enterprise Zone is an important incentive for the County to encourage existing			
businesses to expand and in attracting new businesses to locate within Cecil County; and			
WHEREAS, the application for the subject Enterprise Zone must be filed with the State of Maryland			
Department of Commerce on or before October 15, 2019.

0	MARYLAND, that this application to expand the Cecil County Enterprise Zone to include twenty (20) parcel
