Councilman Miller attended lunch at the West Nottingham Academy. The Kilby Dairy has arranged to take food waste from the school for use in their anaerobic digester to generate methane gas. He stated that the Kilby Dairy supplies the school with ice cream and milk. This equipment will significantly reduce the volume of waste generated. He attended the Fair Hill International meeting and announced plans for a five star Christmas event on December 8 at the mansion.

Vice President Gregory stated that Congressman Harris held a town meeting in North East last week that was well attended. She attended a video horseracing event at the North East Fire Company. She stated that the North East VFW post held a moving Veterans Day service. She also commented on the county's ceremony held last week to honor nine Cecil County soldiers who lost their lives in the Vietnam War. She also stated that the families of these fallen heroes had experienced a great loss.
