Supplemental Appropriation – Fund Balance – Cecil College – Small Capital Budget

1 WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 505 of the Cecil County Charter, on April 1, 2019, the 2 County Executive submitted a proposed budget to the County Council for Fiscal Year 2020; and 3 WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 506 of the Cecil County Charter, the County Council held 4 public hearings on the proposed budget submitted by the County Executive for Fiscal Year 2020; and 5 WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 507(b) of the Cecil County Charter, on June 4, 2019, the 6 Budget for Cecil County was adopted for Fiscal Year 2020; and WHEREAS, the County Executive is revising the Fiscal Year 2020 revenue estimate for Cecil 7 8 County to increase use of the Assigned Fund Balance for Cecil College by \$48,500 to allow the following 9 appropriation within the General Fund: the addition of \$48,500 in expenditures for two incomplete 10 FY2019 small capital projects. The FY2019 Approved Budget for small capital projects at Cecil College 11 was funded in the amount of \$162,000. At June 30, 2019, there was a balance in the account of \$65,120. The dugout pump shed external maintenance, located at the baseball field (\$35,000) and the 12 13 PE Building Chiller Coils repair (\$13,500) were not complete at the end of FY2019 and the College 14 requested to have the funds available in FY2020 to complete the projects, which will leave an unobligated balance of \$16,620; and 15 16 WHEREAS, such appropriation is necessary to provide \$48,500 of the County Executive's FY2019 17 assigned fund balance for the General Fund for expenditures. 18 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CECIL COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for Cecil County, Maryland for Fiscal 19 20 Year 2020 is hereby amended for the supplemental appropriation and by amending the Current Budget to appropriate \$48,500 of additional expenditures in the General Fund to fund Cecil College's small 21 22 capital budget. AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CECIL COUNTY, MARYLAND, that 23 this Resolution shall take effect on the date of its passage. 24

SUMMARY OF LEGISLATION

SPONSOR: Council President Meffley at the request of the County Executive

RESOLUTION NO. 77-2019 - Supplemental Appropriation - Fund Balance - Cecil College - Small Capital Projects

SYNOPSIS: A resolution to amend the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for Cecil County, Maryland for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020 in order to provide the Cecil College Small Capital Budget within the General Fund, expenditure appropriation authority to authorize \$48,500 to be expended for FY2019 small capital projects that were not completed by June 30, 2019.

FISCAL IMPACT SUMMARY: The approval of this bill will have a net fiscal impact on the Cecil County of \$48,500, by expending the FY2019 assigned fund balance designated by the County Executive to provide carryover funding for the unspent Cecil College small capital budget

FISCAL ANALYSIS:

At the end of FY2019, the College informed the County it would be unable to complete two of its scheduled FY2019 small capital projects by the end of the fiscal year. The external maintenance to the baseball/dugout pump shed and the repair of the PE Chiller Coils. As the College's small capital budget is part of the County's annual operating budget, any funds not spent by June 30 revert back to the fund balance of the general fund. In anticipation of not completing the two projects by fiscal year end, the College proactively asked for the funds to be carried over to FY2020. In order to appropriate the funds back to the College, the County Executive assigned the funds to the College to allow the completion of the two small capital projects.

Although the County Executive has the power to assign fund balance, the Council, per Charter, must approve changes to the approved budget.

In the FY 2019 Operating/Minor Capital budget, the County Council approved \$162,000 for various facilities related projects around campus. To date, \$96,880 has been billed to the County.

The College respectfully requests that the balance of the PE Chiller Coils Repair (\$13,500) and the total of the Dugout Pump Shed External Maintenance (\$35,000) be carried forward into FY 2020. The remaining funds (\$16,620) can be unobligated.
