1 **WHEREAS**, , the Cecil Soil Conservation District was established as a public body corporate and
2 politic, exercising public powers, pursuant to Sections 8-301(7) and Section 8-306(a), of the Maryland
3 Annotated Code, Agriculture Article; and

4 **WHEREAS**, the governing body of each Soil Conservation District consists of five supervisors who
5 shall be interested and knowledgeable in conservation of soil, water, and related natural resources,
6 pursuant to Section 8-302(b) of the Agricultural Article; and

7 **WHEREAS**, the Supervisors shall be appointed, in consideration of representation from farming,
8 forestry, wildlife, and urban interest; and

9 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 8-302, the procedure for the appointment of five supervisors
10 requires that one district resident to be appointed by the County Executive and approved by the County
11 Council, one supervisor to be appointed by the State Soil Conservation Committee as recommended by
12 the county farm bureau, one supervisor to be appointed by the State Soil Conservation Committee as
13 recommended by the county extension service, and two supervisors to be appointed by the State Soil
14 Conservation Committee from among the residents of the Soil Conservation District; and

15 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 8-306, the duties of the Supervisors include conducting research,
16 disseminating information, conducting demonstrations in soil erosion and preventative measures,
17 carrying out preventative and control measures on State owned land, supporting erosion and prevention
18 operations, acquiring, maintaining and disposing of property, providing equipment and supplies to assist
19 land owners in conserving soil resources, developing comprehensive plans for conserving soil resources,
20 assisting other government agencies with soil conservation projects, reviewing plans for clearing, grading
21 and transporting soil as required by MDE, and establishing a fee system to cover the cost of reviewing
22 grading and sediment control plans; and

23 **WHEREAS**, the County Executive has recommended Bruce Yerkes for reappointment as Supervisor
24 to the Cecil County Soil Conservation Board, to a four year term, which is to expire on January 21, 2024.

25 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED THAT THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CECIL COUNTY,**
26 **MARYLAND**, confirms the recommendation by the County Executive of Bruce Yerkes for reappointment to
27 the Cecil County Soil Conservation Board, to a four year term, which is to expire on January 21, 2024.

28 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CECIL COUNTY, MARYLAND**, that this
29 Resolution shall take effect on the date of its passage.
