**Title of Resolution: Supplemental Appropriation – Grants Fund – State’s Attorney’s Office – Asset Forfeiture**

**Synopsis:** A Resolution to amend the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for Cecil County, Maryland, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020, in the amount of \$47,232 within the Special Revenue – Other Grants Fund – State’s Attorney’s Office, in order to record the Town of Elkton, Maryland, granting a portion of an asset forfeiture to the agency.

1           **WHEREAS**, in accordance with Section 505 of the Cecil County Charter, on April 1, 2019, the  
2 County Executive submitted a proposed budget to the County Council for Fiscal Year 2020; and

3           **WHEREAS**, in accordance with Section 506 of the Cecil County Charter, the County Council held  
4 public hearings on the proposed budget submitted by the County Executive for Fiscal Year 2020; and

5           **WHEREAS**, in accordance with Section 507(b) of the Cecil County Charter, on June 4, 2019, the  
6 Budget for Cecil County was adopted for Fiscal Year 2020; and

7           **WHEREAS**, the County Executive is revising the Fiscal Year 2020 Special Revenue – Other Grants  
8 Fund revenue estimate for Cecil County to allow the following appropriation of \$47,232 in expenditures to  
9 the Special Revenue – Other Grants Fund operating budget to allow use of an asset forfeiture from the  
10 Town of Elkton, Maryland that was shared with the Cecil County States Attorney’s Office; and

11           **WHEREAS**, such appropriation is necessary to provide \$47,232 of funding to allow the State’s  
12 Attorney’s Office the expenditure authority necessary to use the funds from a forfeiture, which was the  
13 result of a plea agreement by which the Defendant had to forfeit his home to the Town of Elkton. An  
14 agreement was made between the Town of Elkton and the Office of the State’s Attorney to split the net  
15 proceeds from the sale of the home with 60% going to the Town and 40% going to the Office of the  
16 State’s Attorney. The department, being mindful of certain spending restrictions on seized funds, will use  
17 the money to supplement for the cost of training and travel, as well as new equipment necessary for the  
18 operation of the Office.

19           **NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CECIL COUNTY,**  
20 **MARYLAND**, that the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for Cecil County, Maryland for Fiscal  
21 Year 2020 is hereby amended for the supplemental appropriation; and by amending the Current Budget  
22 to appropriate additional expenditures in the Other Grants Fund – Special Revenue – State’s Attorney’s  
23 Office to record the amount of \$47,232 awarded by the Town of Elkton, Maryland.

24           **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CECIL COUNTY, MARYLAND**, that all  
25 provisions of this Resolution shall take effect on the date that the Resolution is approved.
