WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 505 of the Cecil County Charter, on April 1, 2019, the County 1 2 Executive submitted a proposed budget to the County Council for Fiscal Year 2020; and 3 WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 506 of the Cecil County Charter, the County Council held 4 public hearings on the proposed budget submitted by the County Executive for Fiscal Year 2020; and 5 WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 507(b) of the Cecil County Charter, on June 4, 2019, the 6 Budget for Cecil County was adopted for Fiscal Year 2020; and 7 WHEREAS, the County Executive is revising the Fiscal Year 2020 Special Revenue Other Grants Fund 8 - Health Department revenue estimate for Cecil County to establish the following amount: the addition of 9 \$16,199,744 in grant revenue and expense to the Special Revenue Other Grants Fund – Health Department 10 grants operating budget in order to provide the necessary CARES Act funding to help Cecil County with 11 expenses associated with the COVID-19 pandemic; and 12 WHEREAS, such appropriation is necessary to provide \$16,199,744 in funding to be used in Cecil County per the guidelines established of the federal government to cover expenses directly related to 13 14 combating the spread of COVID-19 in Cecil County from the period March 1, 2020 to December 30, 2020; 15 and 16 WHEREAS, the grant money awarded to Cecil County is awarded in two parts. The first half of the 17 funding is being held by the local health department, and the second half of the funding is being held by 18 the County. The available grant funding is to include expenditures of Cecil County Government, the 19 Department of Social Services, the volunteer fire service and all towns and municipalities located within Cecil County. 20 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CECIL COUNTY, 21 22 MARYLAND, that the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for Cecil County, Maryland for Fiscal 23 Year 2020 is hereby amended for the supplemental appropriation and by amending the Current Budget to 24 appropriate \$16,199,744 in additional expenditures in the Special Revenue Other Grants Fund – Health 25 Department to record the grant from the United States Department of the Treasury for the purpose of
