8	change or repeal any or all of the provisions of said Cecil County, Maryland, Personnel Policies and

10	WHEREAS, the County Executive has determined that it is in the best interest of Cecil County to
11	repeal the existing Cecil County, Maryland Personnel Policies and Procedures Manual, and to replace the
12	repealed regulations by enacting a new Personnel Policies and Procedures Manual, in order to comply
13	with changes in applicable laws, to respond to certain changes to employee benefits and expectations for
14	employment, to provide for the health, safety and welfare of County employees and County citizens, and
15	to further the County Executive's commitment to providing the citizens of Cecil County by instilling the
16	following values as guiding principles for all interactions with each other and with County citizens:
17	Teamwork, flexibility, accountability, mutual respect, excellence, and open & effective communication;

20	for adoption by the County Council is attached hereto and incorporated by reference as if more fully set
