# Chairman's Report - Mike Ratchford

## Review of EDC Fall 2020 Survey – Mike Ratchford

- Received 13 out of 21 responses.
- Seems EDC is on right track; received good suggestions for improving.
- Meetings great forum for providing information to business community, having speakers, suggesting policy
- Suggestion to redo subcommittee structure replace Finance and Communication subcommittees
  with new Small Business and Agriculture subcommittees; restrict to four subcommittees OED
  tasked to work on proposal, changing charters, focus/passions of committees
- Cecil Chamber putting together new Government Relations Committee provides voice on legislative matters

- Plan to invite new administration to EDC meeting in Jan-Feb of 2021. New OED director to start December 7<sup>th</sup>.
- Invite suggestions for speakers, topics, etc. Like idea of working with Chamber committee

# Acting Director's Report – Sandra Edwards

- Administering grants through CARES Act funding and State funding for Restaurant Relief
  - When finished will be giving out \$1.8M through CARES 2, started out with \$1.5M, Administration made up difference
  - Restaurant Relief grant gave out \$663,000 from State, County using CARES Act funding to cover difference to \$860,000
  - People still contacting us regarding grant funding available looking at putting together additional grants but time running out, holiday schedules, new administration
- Received Micro Ag program grant in partnership with Upper Shore Regional Council will be in 2021
- Still receiving prospect calls
- New director coming onboard

## Workforce Update - Bruce England

- Thank Mike for leadership of committee over years
- Data from last month's meeting hasn't changed
- Hiring companies across variety of industries still hiring; trying to attract people back into workforce, training programs
- Dec. 10<sup>th</sup> hosting Virtual Hiring event; may do monthly if successful

# Education Update (Cecil College) – Dr. Mary Bolt

- Cecil College's Career Center participating making students aware of Virtual Hiring event
- Bio Processing degree passed brings good-paying jobs in County/regionally
- Classes starting in Spring about 12% on campus, 44% synchronous, 44% asynchronous
- Have GEARS funding left training available for companies
- College open for business

## Education/Library Update (CCPL) - Morgan Miller

- Operational Status Perryville, Elkton, and Chesapeake City branches open in limited capacity, access computers, resources, and librarians
  - Will stay open as long as safe to do so
  - Rising Sun and Cecilton running contactless pick ups
- Working on outreach solutions; i.e., Book Mobile, computers
  - Trying to get computers, technology, and high speed internet to people
- Spent summer building new website for Library page for businesses and nonprofits, 2<sup>nd</sup> page for jobs/careers
- Content Learning Videos available
- Hiring for North East Library -- Library should be completed after new year and opening in mid-April
- Team Librarians recognized across State by Citizens for Libraries Outstanding Employees of the Year, especially for Start Up Cecil

## Communications Subcommittee – JoAnn Dawson

Second movie to be filmed in Cecil County in March-April unless picked up by Hallmark

# Union Hospital Update - Dr. Rich Szumel

- Integration with Christiana phenomenal
- Currently have more Covid positive cases in hospitals than any time during Pandemic
- Have surge plans if needed
- On Divert -- OR, ICU, PCU full; other hospitals in area on Divert
- Spread the Word need to social distance, wear mask
- Expect another peak in 2-3 weeks
- Great communication with County, State, and with mothership
- New vaccines logistical nightmare of distributing
  - 2 Manufacturers
  - Phizer vaccine difficult storage requirements; ordered freezers to store
  - Require 2 doses; window of time between is 21 days (Phizer)
  - Require vaccines come from same lot recordkeeping will be extremely difficult
  - Vaccine will be distributed in limited quantity
  - CDC guidance on vaccine distribution healthcare workers, vulnerable populations
  - Who would be distribution site(s)? Waiting for disposition on this
- Dr. Szumel leaving Christiana/Union at end of month position being eliminated
  - Christiana will administer via leadership triad will let Mike and Debbie (Chamber) know contact information
