Supplemental Appropriation – Fund Balance - Volunteer Fire Services – Vehicle Replacement Program

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 505 of the Cecil County Charter, on April 1, 2020, the 1 County Executive submitted a proposed budget to the County Council for Fiscal Year 2021; and 2 WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 506 of the Cecil County Charter, the County Council held 3 public hearings on the proposed budget submitted by the County Executive for Fiscal Year 2021; and 4 WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 507(b) of the Cecil County Charter, on May 19, 2020, the 5 Budget for Cecil County was adopted for Fiscal Year 2021; and 6 WHEREAS, the County Executive is revising the Fiscal Year 2021 revenue estimate for Cecil County 7 to increase use of the Assigned Fund Balance for Volunteer Fire Company Vehicle Replacement by 8 \$250,000, to allow the following appropriation within the General Fund: the addition of \$250,000 in 9 expenditures for the Volunteer Fire Service Vehicle Replacement Program. The FY2021 Approved Budget 10 for the replacement program was funded in the amount of \$575,000. There were additional equipment 11 replacement requests submitted for FY2021 that were not funded, but in need of replacement. The 12 County Executive decided to assign fund balance when the FY2020 financials were completed and funds 13 were available to partially fund the FY2021 request; and 14 WHEREAS, such appropriation is necessary to provide \$250,000 of the County Executive's FY2020 15 assigned fund balance for the General Fund for expenditures. 16 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CECIL COUNTY, 17 MARYLAND, that the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for Cecil County, Maryland, for Fiscal 18 Year 2021 is hereby amended for the supplemental appropriation; and by amending the Current Budget 19 to appropriate \$250,000 of additional expenditures in the General Fund to the Volunteer Fire Service 20 Department's budget. 21 AND, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CECIL COUNTY, MARYLAND, 22 that this Resolution shall take effect on the date of its passage. 23 INTRODUCED: January 19, 2021 ADOPTED: February 2, 2021 President of the Council

SUMMARY OF LEGISLATION

SPONSOR: Council President at the request of the County Executive

RESOLUTION NO. 13-2021 – Supplemental Appropriation – Fund Balance – Volunteer Fire Services – Vehicle Replacement Program.

SYNOPSIS: A Resolution to amend the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for Cecil County, Maryland, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021 in order to provide the Volunteer Fire Service Department's budget within the General Fund expenditure appropriation authority to authorize \$250,000 to be expended for the County's match portion towards the Vehicle Replacement Program.

<u>FISCAL IMPACT SUMMARY</u>: The approval of this bill will have a net fiscal impact on the Cecil County of \$250,000, by expending the FY2020 assigned fund balance designated by the County Executive to provide additional funding for the Volunteer Fire Company Vehicle Replacement Program.

FISCAL ANALYSIS:

It is within the power of the County Executive to determine if funds need to be set aside to benefit and/or safeguard the County against the risk of large unbudgeted expenditures. The constraints of the FY2021 Budget did not allow the County to fund the entire equipment request for new fire company vehicles (see below - total FY2021 request). The completion of the FY2020 financials proved to have sufficient funds available to appropriate additional budget to the VFC's in order to fund two additional ambulances. The funds will remain assigned until expended.

Although the County Executive has the power to assign fund balance, the Council, per Charter, must approve changes to the approved budget.
