- 1 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CECIL COUNTY,
- 2 MARYLAND, that a new chapter of the Code of Cecil County to be titled "250. Noise in Residential Areas",

- 5 A. A PERSON SHALL NOT MAKE OR CAUSE TO BE MADE BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 11:00 P.M. AND
- 6 6:00 A.M. ANY NOISE PRODUCED VOCALLY, WITH ANY RADIO RECEIVING SET, MUSICAL INSTRUMENT,
- 7 PHONOGRAPHY, ANY DEVICE INTENDED FOR THE PRODUCTION OR REPRODUCTION OF SOUND, OR ANY
- 8 HOUSEHOLD TOOL OR OTHER HOUSEHOLD EQUIPMENT, IF THE NOISE IS AUDIBLE ON ANY PROPERTY
- 9 THAT IS USED FOR RESIDENTIAL PURPOSES AND IS LOCATED MORE THAN 50 FEET FROM THE SOURCE
- 10 **OF THE NOISE.**
- 11 B. A PERSON SHALL NOT MAKE OR CAUSE TO BE MADE BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 6:00 AM. AND 11
- 12 P.M. ANY NOISE PRODUCED VOCALLY, WITH ANY RADIO RECEIVING SET, MUSICAL INSTRUMENT,
- 13 PHONOGRAPHY, ANY DEVICE INTENDED FOR THE PRODUCTION OR REPRODUCTION OF SOUND, OR ANY
- 14 HOUSEHOLD TOOL OR OTHER HOUSEHOLD EQUIPMENT, IF THE NOISE IS AUDIBLE ON ANY PROPERTY
- 15 THAT IS USED FOR RESIDENTIAL PURPOSES AND IS LOCATED MORE THAN 100 FEET FROM THE SOURCE
- 16 **OF THE NOISE.**
- 17 C. THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO NOISE RESULTING FROM:
- 18 (1) THE OPERATIONS OF A PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY AS DEFINED IN THE PUBLIC UTILITIES
- 19 ARTICLE, DIVISION I. PUBLIC SERVICES AND UTILITIES; TITLE 1. DEFINITIONS, SECTION 1-02(X) OF THE
- 20 ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND
- 21 (2) THE OPERATIONS OF AN INSTRUMENTALITY OF THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT, STATE
- 22 GOVERNMENT, OR COUNTY GOVERNMENT
- 23 (3) THE OPERATIONS OF A VOLUNTEER FIRE AND AMBULANCE COMPANY
- 24 (4) THE OPERATION OF FARM EQUIPMENT; OR
- 25 (5) THE OPERATIONS OF A BUSINESS OR INDUSTRIAL FACILITY, PROVIDED THAT THE NOISE IS
- 26 NOT PRODUCED FROM A SOURCE AS DEFINED IN SUBSECTION A OF THIS SECTION.
- 27 D. A PERSON WHO FAILS TO STOP MAKING OR CAUSING TO BE MADE ANY NOISE THAT VIOLATES
- 28 THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION AFTER HAVING BEEN ORDERED TO DO SO BY A LAW ENFORCEMENT
- 29 OFFICER, SHALL BE SUBJECT TO A CIVIL FINE.

30	E. A	PERSON WHO VIOLATES THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION SHALL BE LIABLE FOR A CIVIL FINE	
31	IN THE FOLLOWING AMOUNT:		
32	(1)	\$250 FOR THE FIRST VIOLATION	
33	(2)	\$500 FOR THE SECOND VIOLATION; AND	
34	(3)	\$1,000 FOR THE THIRD VIOLATION AND EACH SUBSEQUENT VIOLATION.
