1 WHEREAS, it is in the public interest that law enforcement agencies throughout the State of Maryland and the United States cooperate to the greatest extent possible so as to provide prompt, 2 3 effective, and professional law enforcement services; and 4 WHEREAS, the law enforcement officers of the Wicomico County, Worcester County, Somerset County, Dorchester County, Talbot County, Caroline County, Queen Anne's County, and Kent County are 5 6 respectively trained in current law enforcement techniques and have completed a course of training 7 prescribed by the Maryland Police Training Commission pursuant to the Public Safety Article, §2-207, Annotated Code of Maryland; and 8 9 WHEREAS, the County Council of Cecil County, Maryland is aware that from time to time, emergency situations have occurred at locations and times in interconnected, adjacent, or coterminous 10 jurisdictions when sufficient law enforcement resources were not immediately available to allow for the 11 responsible jurisdiction to provide prompt, effective, and professional services to the public; and 12 WHEREAS, the Cecil County Sheriff's Office now desires to enter into Mutual Aid Agreements with 13 county governments and county sheriffs of Wicomico County, Worcester County, Somerset County, 14 Dorchester County, Talbot County, Caroline County, Queen Anne's County, and Kent County, respectively, 15 16 so as to assure that law enforcement in the aforesaid jurisdictions are adequately prepared, to greatest extent practicable, to provide prompt, effective, and professional law enforcement services to the public; 17 and 18

WHEREAS, the County Council is now resolved to authorize the execution, by the County Executive and the Cecil County Sheriff, of Mutual Aid Agreements, in substantially the form and content as that set forth in Appendix 1, the Law Enforcement Mutual Aid Agreement, which is incorporated by reference as if set forth herein, with the county governments and county sheriffs of Wicomico County, Worcester County, Somerset County, Dorchester County, Talbot County, Caroline County, Queen Anne's County, and Kent County, respectively.
