1	WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 1321.57(a) of the Older Americans Act of 1965, the area
2	agency on aging shall establish an advisory council that shall carry out advisory functions that
3	further the area agency's mission of developing and coordinating community-based systems of
4	services for all older persons in the planning and service area, and
5	WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 1321.57(b) of the Older Americans Act of 1965, the council
6	shall include individuals and representatives of community organizations who will help to enhance
7	the leadership role of the area agency in developing community-based systems of service; and
8	WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 10 Human Services, Section 201 of the Annotated Code of
9	Maryland, the Maryland Department of Aging was created as a principal executive department to
10	administer programs mandated by the federal government throughout the state through the Area
11	Agencies on Aging; and
12	WHEREAS, the Maryland Department of Aging has designated the Senior Services and
13	Community Transit of Cecil County as the Area Agency on Aging; and
14	WHEREAS, the Cecil County Commission on Aging oversees the provision of services to
15	seniors as the advisory council to the Area Agency on Aging in Cecil County; and
16	WHEREAS, the Commission on Aging identifies, assesses, and advocates for the needs of the
17	growing older adult population in Cecil County; encourages the development of services designed to
18	address those needs; and supports the mission of the Senior Services and Community Transit of
19	Cecil County of developing and coordinating community-based systems of services for all older
20	adults in the County; and
21	WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 412(b) of the Charter of Cecil County, the County Executive
22	shall appoint all members of boards and commissions and that such membership shall be subject to
23	confirmation by the Council; and
24	WHEREAS, the County Executive has recommended the reappointment to the Cecil County
25	Commission on Aging of Carol King and Julianne Graham to a three-year term, which will expire on
26	June 20, 2024.
27	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED THAT THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CECIL
